Signature Academies are four-year themed high school programs. Students enter the program in 9th grade and complete a four-year program of study, which includes job shadow, internship, and advanced research opportunities. Each program is designed to engage and motivate students through:

- a rigorous course of study
- applied curriculum that includes opportunities to earn college credit and industry certifications
- community partnerships that help students connect school and the real world
- leadership activities where students can gain necessary 21st century skills

Signature School: Wooster High School offers an International Baccalaureate (IB) programs for all students. IB's mission is to create a better world through education by providing a comprehensive and rigorous curriculum that encourages international-mindedness in students and prepares them for a high-quality university experience. Through integration of knowledge and skills, along with focus on independent, critical and creative thought, the IB curriculum focuses on educating the whole person in the context of a lifelong journey toward responsible citizenship. Wooster High School IB offers the following programs:

Signature School: The Academy of Arts, Careers & Technology (AACT) is a career and technical education (CTE) high school for students in grades 9-12 who have a focused career interest. QUALIFICATIONS FOR SIGNATURE ACADEMY ELIGIBILITY:

Eligibility for enrollment in a Signature Academy is based on qualifications set by WCSD that demonstrate a student's commitment to academic success, and these are determined by an average of performance in the 7th and 8th grade year. Information to determine eligibility will be taken from WCSD Infinite Campus records; for students not currently enrolled in WCSD, applicants must provide 7th and 8th grade transcripts, behavior records, attendance records, and their most recent standardized test results in Math and Reading to the Signature Academies & CTE Department.

It is recommended that students are qualified in EACH of the following areas to be eligible for enrollment*:

- GPA: Recommended 2.0 overall GPA in core classes (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies); failing grades are not recommended
- Standardized Test Scores: Recommended Meets Standards on standardized tests taken in 7th and 8th grade
- Attendance: Regular school attendance (a minimum 90% is recommended)
- Self-Management: Demonstrations of appropriate self-management abilities (no behavior incidents which involved injury to another person, distribution of drugs, or weapons)

**Students who are found ineligible based on the qualifications above may request a review of the decision by contacting the WCSD SACTE Department within 45 calendar days of the ineligibility notification mailing date. The full process for requesting this review can be found at www.washoeschools.net/SignatureAcademies in the Policies & Procedures document (page 4 & 5).*

ADMISSION PROCESS for the 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR:

- Submit the Signature Academy Application for admission by January 1, 2021.
- Only one completed application per student which can include only ONE Signature Academy choice. If you need to make any changes to your application or Signature Academy choice, please contact us at SignaturePrograms@washoeschools.net
- Admission decisions are made using a blind review process.
- A confirmation email will be sent, or phone call made from the Department of Signature Academies and Career & Technical Education confirming application receipt.
- Students deemed eligible will be considered for available Signature Academy seats. If the number of applicants for a Signature Academy Program exceeds the number of seats in the program, the District will randomly select qualified students to fill the seats (a lottery system). SIGNATURE ACADEMY AGREEMENTS

Attendance is a Privilege

Enrollment will continue from year to year provided that students continue to meet the grade, credit, attendance, and GPA qualifications as stated in the guidelines above to be accepted. Students not meeting these qualifications may be placed on academic or behavioral intervention by their Signature Academy school for up to 2 semesters. At the conclusion of the intervention period, students who continue to not meet the minimum recommended qualifications may be removed from their Signature Academy program at the discretion of their school principal.

Available spaces in Signature Academies are limited and highly competitive. Students who accept one of the available spaces are required to make a commitment to remain enrolled through the conclusion of the school year. (NOTE: Requests for release from a Signature Academy prior to the end of the commitment period must be submitted in writing through the school counselor and must be reviewed/approved by the Signature Academy Department and Deputy Superintendent's Office.)

Transportation

Transportation is provided from/to the nearest high school for Signature Schools ONLY (AACT and Wooster). To access transportation, students/families must provide transportation to and from the nearest high school, as schedules for busses for zoned students will not overlap with Signature School bus schedules to allow for door-to-door service. There is no district sponsored transportation for any other Signature Academy program.

Student athletes attending a Signature Academy at a school other than their zoned high school are eligible to participate in any sanctioned sub-varsity sport offered at the Signature Academy school as a freshman (NAC 386.787/NRS 386.430). Students who are selected to play at the varsity level during the freshman year (including sports that don't offer a sub-varsity level) can petition the Signature Academy Department to be placed on a magnet variance which will allow conditional participation. Sibling Policy

It is the intent of WCSD to avoid separating siblings, when possible. If a sibling is already enrolled in and will be attending the Signature School or Academy to which his/her sibling applies, and the sibling will continue to be enrolled in the Signature School or Academy for the coming school year, WCSD will give a preference to the sibling to attend the Signature School or Academy. To be eligible for the sibling preference, the parent/guardian must submit a Signature Application for the incoming sibling by the annually specified deadline date AND the incoming sibling must be deemed eligible by meeting all admission qualifications and/or requirements.

The following additional information MUST be submitted prior to the application deadline:

1. Transcript of 7th grade school year and first semester of 8th grade (as soon as available)
2. Discipline and attendance records from 7th grade school year and first semester of 8th grade
3. Most current state standardized test results in Math and Reading (such as CRTs, Iowa Tests, etc.)

Applications will not be processed until all documentation is received. If this occurs after the deadline date, applications will be processed in MARCH as part of the late application process.

Note: If standardized test scores are not available or testing was administered prior to the 7th grade year, the student will be administered an alternate math and/or reading test to be used for application purposes.
