There are 3 components to the class:

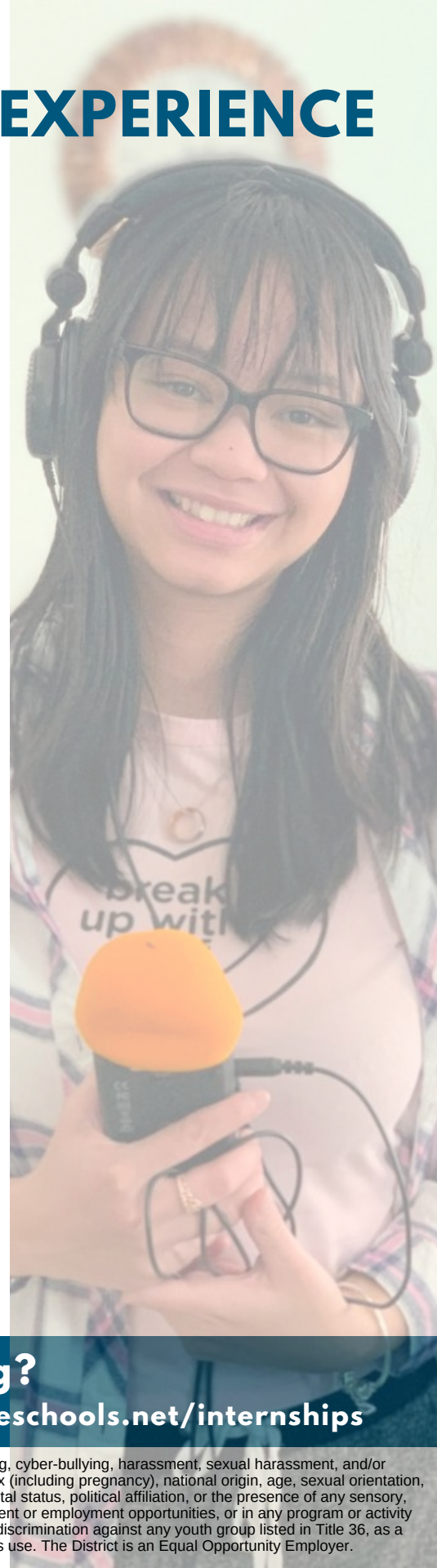
- Weekly Classwork in Journalism, Public Radio, Audio Recording, and Employability Skills.
