All grade level standards are expected to be taught; however, the essential [standards](#) need to be mastered/secured prior to the end of the school year.

ELA

Reading Foundational Skills:

RF.3.3b: Decode words with common Latin suffixes.

RF.3.3c: **Decode** multisyllable words.

RF.3.3d: Read grade-appropriate **irregularly spelled words**.

RF.3.4a Read **grade-level text** with purpose and understanding.

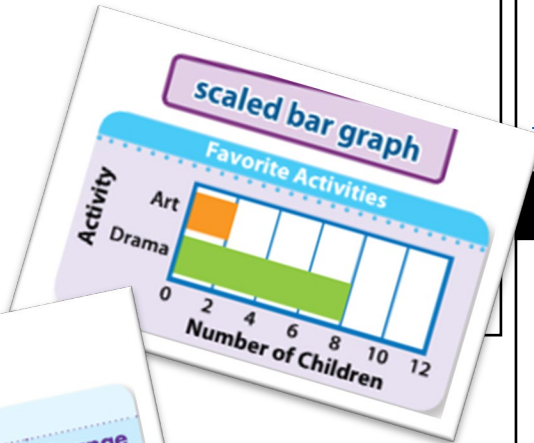
