

First Stop: Universal Design

Classroom Level Supports in General/Special Education classroom

Supports and tools that are common and freely available

For example: Text-to-Speech, Speech-to-Text, Visual Supports, Accessible Educational Material (e.g. Bookshare), Graphic Organizers

Level 1:

- ◇ Student has current EP or 504 plan
- ◇ Eligible under Specific Learning Disability (SLD) or Mild Health Impairment (HI)
- ◇ Student is primarily in the general education setting
- ◇ Current assessment data has been collected by the team including any of the following:
 - MAP/SBAC
 - Academic Achievement
 - Formal and Informal Assess.
 - Writing Samples
 - QSI
 - DRA
 - End of Course Exams
 - Work Samples
 - Behavior Data
 - Speech and Language Assess.
 - Grades

Staff Support for AT or AT Consult written in to IEP (Consult if team has no information about what supports might be

Level 2:

- ◇ Current assessment data has been collected by the team including any of the following:
 - MAP/SBAC
 - Academic Achievement
 - Formal and Informal Assess.
 - Writing Samples
 - QSI
 - DRA
 - End of Course Exams
 - Work Samples
 - Behavior Data
 - Speech and Language Assess.
 - Grades
- ◇ Student receives other related services, such as— Speech and Language, OT, PT, VI, O & M, APE, Audiology
- ◇ Additional forms the team might utilize are Inclusion Matrix, Student Observations, Discrepancy Analysis, Current AT Implementation Data

AT Consult written in to IEP (if team has needs guidance with selecting/obtaining materials) or Staff Support for AT (staff will provide supports and are knowledgeable about AT)

Level 3:

- ◇ Team had some student information, but it is inconclusive or can't provide adequate information
- ◇ Student needs are complex
- ◇ Related service providers and/or community resources are in place
- ◇ Parent has requested assessment

Assessment written into IEP and includes:

- Signed consent for evaluation
- Related services referral form
- Team Conducts additional assessment – e.g. WATI, FEAT, Functional Communication Profile)
- Revision to IEP
