# Counselor's Corner-Ms. Fries

Wow! Jesse Hall is serving all students! The Home Visit program is up and running. Teachers & administrators are meeting students at their home, recreational center and parks. It has been so much fun getting to know the students' family cultures and traditions. If you are interested in a home visit, you can contact the classroom teacher or Ms. Fries.

In addition to the home visit connection, staff is also moving towards classroom Restorative Circles. The Restorative Circle is similar to classroom morning meetings in that, there is a time set aside to meet as a class. They are structured intentional spaces designed to promote connection, understanding and dialogue in a group. The goal is building trusting relationships and increasing social emotional learning and skills. We would also expect to see, over time, a decrease in difficult behaviors. The aspects that are practiced in the Circles are respect, equality, empathy and emotional literacy, problem solving, responsibility, self-awareness and selfregulation and shared leadership. Allimportant qualities in growing healthy social humans and part of our SEL competencies.

#### Washoe County School District

Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act—Management Plan Notification

On October 22, 1986 the President of the United States, signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) to CFR 763. AHERA requires all school districts throughout the United States, including Washoe County School District, to inspect their schools for asbestos and to develop a Management Plan which identified the location of all asbestos in each school.

A requirement of AHERA is that Washoe County School District is to notify the public annually that these Management Plans are available for review in each school's main office.
