♦ Family Engagement Objective 1: By using the Home Visit Program, we intend to reach 40 families as well as hosting Family Literature Club, Bullying Information Night, and Quarterly themed Family Engagement, we hope to reach 25% of our families (as measured by sign in sheets), we will have a specific focus on our Native American population with the goal to visit 13 homes and reach 25% with a goal of increasing academic performance.

* Family Engagement Objective 2: During the 2019-2020 school year, Jesse Hall Elementary will increase family participation in the Family Literacy Club sessions with the objective of increasing parent/guardian knowledge and capacity in s supporting student's literacy instruction at home (reading, writing, speaking and listening). We would like to meet with 50 families, 30% of 1st and 2nd grade families. Measurable artifacts include parent participation rates, family feedback after each of the 4 sessions, and anecdotal evidence from teachers as to increased communication with participating families. This goal building upon the success of Family Literacy clubs, the previous year with parents/guardians of kindergarten students.
