PICK-UP AND CROSSWALK REQUESTS

- Please only cross the street using the crosswalk!
 - If you are exiting the lower parking lot, please do not walk from the cafeteria side in the street towards the crosswalk. Please head towards the crosswalk through the parking lot.
 - If you are parked along Surrey toward the dead end, please stay to the right side until you are beyond the Surrey/Kitts intersection.
 - Please DO NOT walk diagonally across the Surrey/Kitts intersection. Instead, wait for the crossing guard to stop traffic.
 - If you are meeting your child, please do so in the parking lot near the gate. Please do not wait on Surrey.
 - Please do not allow your students to run between the parked cars.
 - Please encourage your students to meet you EITHER in the pickup line OR in the parking lot near the gate. We want to keep the grass space behind the cafeteria clear, so we know which children are accounted for.
 - If you are chatting with parents after school, please be sure to keep an eye on your student-off the wall, out of the street, etc.
- *All of this will help keep pedestrian traffic out of the street except for the crosswalk area. It keeps our cars moving and, most importantly, families safe!

NEWS FROM THE LIBRARY



Our Fall Book Fair was a huge success! In 5 days we sold \$8,900.00 in books and other book fair items.
