<b>12th Grade</b> <i>needs course to graduate with the 2020 class</i>	Before 4/1	6/5	No	Student will earn their overall grade and no lower than a “D” if the overall grade was 60% or higher. If the student had less than 60% overall grade and less than 50% progress, they must first meet 50% progress before earning their overall grade (no lower than a “D”).	Student has a passing overall grade before 4/1 or when student achieves 50% or more progress by time.	Student can be scheduled in their current classes at their high school and up to four Edgenuity online classes. When an online class is complete, another one can be added.
	4/1 – 6/5	6/5	No	The overall grade on 6/5 is the grade they will receive. This cannot be lower than a “D” if the course is at least 50% complete.	If the student achieves 50% or more progress by time, then the student may receive an incomplete and continue the course into summer intersession, but not beyond the current school year.	Student can be scheduled in their current classes at their high school and up to four Edgenuity online classes. When an online class is complete, another one can be added.
<b>12th Grade</b> <i>needs course to graduate with the 2020 class and does not have the minimum to receive a “D” or higher</i>	Before 6/5	Before 10/1	No	Students who do not finish (50% completion by time) may receive an incomplete and continue the course until 10/1.	Student needs the course to graduate and will not be finished until 10/1 or has reached 50% completion. If 50% is not achieved by 10/1, the student will be a 5th-year senior and will need to continue the course through fall 2020. The student will need to complete the course.	Student can be scheduled in their current classes at their high school and up to four Edgenuity online classes. When an online class is complete, another one can be added.
<b>12th Grade</b> <i>needs course to graduate with the 2020 class</i>	6/6 – 10/1	Before 10/1	Yes	Students who complete the course with a passing grade and final exam 60% or higher.	If the student has not completed the course by 10/1, they will become a 5th-year senior and will need to continue the course through fall 2020 and complete the course at 100%.	This does not apply.
<b>9th – 11th Grade</b>	Before 4/1	6/5	No	Student’s overall grade on 6/5, not lower than 4/1 overall grade, and no lower than a “D” (50% progress by time).	When the student completes 50% or more in progress by time.	Student can be scheduled in their current classes at their high school and up to four Edgenuity online classes. When an online class is complete, another one can be added.
<b>9th – 11th Grade</b> <i>does not include summer, bonus, or extra distance education (see teacher)</i>	4/1 – 6/5	6/5	No	The overall grade on 6/5 is the grade they will receive. This cannot be lower than a “D” if the course is at least 50% complete.	When the student completes 50% or more of the course.	Student can be scheduled in their current classes at their high school and up to four Edgenuity online classes. When an online class is complete, another one can be added.
