## **Beginning Band Grading Procedures**

\*Band grades will be determined using the grading categories below.

#### ASSESSMENTS/CONCERT (75% of overall grade)

- <u>Playing tests</u>: These will be done in class once per quarter so I may give each student feedback and grade their progress. Playing tests may be re-taken for a higher grade by the end of the quarter. Students will have the option to perform live for me at a student and teacher arranged time or record themselves playing to be uploaded to Canvas.
- Written assessments: These will be given to show knowledge of music reading, symbols and terms.
  - <u>To note for all assessments</u>: You will always be given ample notification and will only be tested on concepts that have been covered in class. If you are practicing regularly and completing written assignments, you will not have a problem with any of the tests.

#### **CONCERT ATTENDANCE** (20% of overall grade)

We will have several concerts during the year. Your attendance at these events is mandatory and a major part of your grade. If you must miss a concert, please submit a signed parent note with a valid excuse to your band teacher either: two weeks before the concert for prearranged absences or within one week after the concert for unexpected absences (sickness, family emergencies, etc). An alternate assignment will be given for excused absences. If you can avoid scheduling elective surgeries/ procedures before concerts (especially dental), please do! See the band calendar attached so you can ensure your attendance at all concerts this year.

#### **PARTICIPATION/ASSIGNMENTS** (25% of overall grade)

<u>Participation: Your</u> participation is graded according to your preparedness and active participation in class. Participation is totaled per week out of 100 possible points. Below is the breakdown of how participation is calculated (based on a week where  $6^{th}$  grade students are in class 3 times for that week, please note that on weeks where students are seen 2 times per week the values adjust)

- Bringing instrument and all accessories (reeds, oil, etc.):5 points
- Bringing binder with all materials (including pencils): 5 points
- Playing instrument at appropriate times during class as instructed by teacher: 20 points

\*Participation points will also be subtracted if you are off task or disrupting the class.

• <u>Written assignments</u>: There will be an average of 1-2 written assignments per week pertaining to music notation and literacy, if not completed and turned in during class time the expectation is that the written assignment will be completed and turned in by the Friday of that week or it will be marked late.

Please stay active on Canvas as I will do my best to update assignments and due dates as they arrive!

#### **CITIZENSHIP** (Behavior/Work Ethic)

My rules for citizenship are as follows:

- Be respectful to teacher and fellow classmates.
- Do not talk or play out of turn.
- Enter and leave classroom quietly and orderly.
- Employ all the elements of our school positive behavior system.

#### LATE WORK/ABSENT POLICY

- See planner for the Late Work Policy
- If absent, a student's participation grade will be lowered because they were not at school to participate in class. Students will need to practice for 20 minutes in order to raise their participation grade. They can do this before or after school or at lunch, upon Mr. Skinner availability. If they make this up at home, parents must send an email to Mr. Skinner confirming they practiced. A physical log will be available to print out on Canvas. Their participation grade will be raised once the student has practiced.

#### TAKING INSTRUMENTS HOME

- Students are expected to take instruments home every weekend and over Fall, Winter, and Spring Break for practice
- This encourages students to practice their skills at home to continue their growth.
- This is also to give students the time to prepare for playing tests, which are held during class or online.
- Students will be eligible to bring instruments home once the rental form and fee have been handled and I have seen them demonstrate instrument safety properly (usually around week 4)

## Supplies – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Band

Every student is responsible for having the following supplies for sixth grade band class:

- 1. **Instrument** 6<sup>th</sup> grade students pick from the instruments below. Students wanting to play percussion must play a wind instrument during 6<sup>th</sup> grade before transitioning to 7<sup>th</sup> grade.
- 2. Band Book/Binder- will be provided to student from Class Fee.
- 3. Class Fee \$25 beginning band fee is for a Band T-Shirt, Band Book, and Classroom Supplies.
- 4. **Band Folder** (*This will be provided along with other band music*)
- 5. **Pencil** Keep in instrument case as we ABSOLUTELY use them daily.
- 6. **Instrument Accessories** Students renting instruments from Shaw\* will receive all of the following accessories. Students renting from outside sources will have to provide their own supplies. The supplies are as follows:

## **Band Instrument Rental**

For Beginning Band Students

#### **Rental/Purchase Options:**

- **Rent instrument from the school**. Rental fees are \$50 for the school year (<u>Limited inventory</u>- reserved for those on the Free & Reduced Lunch list per district policy). \*There will <u>not</u> be any school Saxophones available to 6th graders.
- **Rent-to-own from a local music store** (*or online*). Approximate Prices: \$30-45/month for flute, clarinet, trumpet and trombone. Saxes and larger instrument are around \$50-80/month. <u>A more in depth explanation will be at the end of this handbook.</u>
- **Purchase from a local music store or online** If you are going to purchase, I will be happy to give input about instrument quality and price.
  - Remember you get what you pay for! No quality band instrument will be less than \$100.

#### **Rental Procedures:**

- From Music Stores: Families review prices from different stores and then go in to rent/buy. More in depth information to be found on last page of handbook
- For School instruments: Parents who are in need of a school instrument submit a School Rental Application (found in the forms section of handbook). The list of those in need of and instrument is then checked for Free & Reduced Lunch eligibility. If the student qualifies and an instrument is available, I will then send home a rental contract. Once those students receive instruments, the inventory will be available on a first come, first served basis. Students will not receive school instruments until I ha ve received contract and payment. The fee for renting a school instrument is \$50 for the year. For questions, please contact me.

## 6th Grade Band Uniform

We will wear our uniform at all concerts. The 6th grade uniform includes:

- Your band t-shirt (included in band fee, will be given out prior to our first concert)
- Nice blue jeans (nice = not ripped up or dirty)
- Close toed shoes, preferably darker in color (No sandals or flip-flops)

These include: Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Tenor/Baritone Saxophone, French Horn, Trombone, Baritone/Euphonium, Tuba, and Percussion Kits. I will do my best to ensure there is an instrument for your student if store rental is not an option. Please note priority for rental instruments will be in the order as follows: Students qualifying for free or reduced lunch, 8<sup>th</sup> grade, 7<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup> grade.


