## NSPF Measure Definitions \& Descriptions

The 4- and 5-year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate (ACGR) calculates the percentage of students graduating with a standard diploma or higher within 4 or 5 years. The 4 -year is based on the 2021 Cohort and 5-year ACGR is based on the 2020 cohort file for returning 2020 Seniors who graduated by October 2021
 ELA (11th) grade. The Nevada Dept of Education determines the cut scores for proficiency on the ACT. For math, this means achieving a score of 20 or higher, and for ELA, means achieving a score of 17 or higher. Students must be enrolled for at least 100 days prior to test.
 exam in grade 9 carry over to their grade 10 year. Scores are included only where the student tested and the student must have been enrolled for 120 days or more.

Advanced Diploma: This measure calculates the percentage of 2020-21 graduates with an Advanced or CCR Diploma (or Honors diploma in WCSD).
Post-secondary preparation measure (PPM Participation): \% of high school students who, at some point during their high school career, did at least one of the following: 1 passed an AP or IB course (earned HS Credit); 2) passed two dual credit courses; 3) completed a Level 1 and 2 CTE program of study ("CTE concentrator").

## State Designations

Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI): CSI schools are identified as the lowest performing Title I schools, according to their NSPF index score OR high schools with a fouryear adjusted cohort graduation rate below $67 \%$ OR Title I schools that have not exited their TSI/ATSI designation after a three-year improvement plan.
Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI): A school identified as TSI when they have one or more subgroups that do not meet performance targets over two consecutive years in the Academic Achievement indicator AND two or more additional indicators.

Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI): A school identified as ATSI is a TSI school that has at least one measured under-performing subgroup that by itself would qualify for a CSI designation.
