The transition from middle school is a big step; however, we have established support systems in place to help our freshmen students every step of the way, beginning with our SEL (Social Emotional Learning) classes geared for all freshmen level students.

Each spring we begin the important process of placing students in courses for the next school year. We put considerable amount of time and effort in this process to place each student in a course/class where they can be as successful as possible and on the pathway of their graduation plan. It truly is hard to believe that summer is almost over and the 2018-2019 academic year is almost here; however, before it ends completely and school starts officially, I would like to provide you with a few important dates and information to help prepare you for the start of the 2018-2019 school year.

• The first day of school is August 6, 2018 at 8:00 a.m. Students' schedules will be available on Infinite Campus on Monday, July 30, 2018. We would like to encourage students to view and print them out for the first day of school. Students will be on a "C" schedule, which means that they will be attending every class period on that day. The subsequent days, students will follow our traditional A-Day, B-Day, rotating block schedule. The 2018-2019 bell schedule is attached for you to reference.

During the first two weeks of school, counselors will be seeing students who have a gap in
their schedule. They will also be assisting with new enrollees to Spanish Springs HS during the
first two weeks of school. Students are to report to their class that is on their schedule. For all
other issues, students are encouraged to email their counselors with their requests for any
changes in their schedules. Class changes will not be granted during the first two weeks of
school.

Bus Transportation schedules are scheduled to be released on July 23, 2018. Transportation schedules can be found by going onto the Washoe County School District website (www.washoeschools.net). Hover over the "Schools" tab, which will take you to a drop-down menu. Click on "Bus Schedules." You will then proceed to fill in Steps 1 -3. The next screen will tell you your school of residence and how far you live from the school. It will indicate if you either live in a ride or non-ride zone. If you are in a ridezone, you will be provided with the pick up and drop off bus times, locations and bus number. You will be prompted if you are in walk-zone or not in a walk zone. If you are in a walk-zone, transportation will not be provided. Parents are encouraged to contact the district transportation department at (775) 337-7769 for questions pertaining to their child/children's bus transportation needs.
