## Digital School Days

Dear K/1 Families,

Because the State of Nevada now requires districts to make up time out of school for closures due to emergency situations such as snow days, WCSD will implement a Digital Learning Day when schools are closed. This is what the plan will look like in our classroom.

Families will receive a Connect ED phone call/email/text message from WCSD announcing the school closures and the implementation of the Digital Learning Day.

By 9 AM you will receive a message from us via email outlining the at-home learning activities required of your child (on page 2 of this letter). Students should complete the assignments on the digital day itself. (Arrangements will be made to make up the work upon your child's return to school if you do not have internet access or electricity.)

Students will be coded as "TEP" (Temporary Educational Placement) once students complete snow day assignments, to indicate that work has been submitted. If a student does not complete the digital day assignment, that code is changed to "unexcused absence."

Digital Learning Day assignments will be graded and posted in IC.
