### Old Business

- 1. Gala Showcase 2022
  - a. Date is set for April 29th at the Renaissance.
    - 1. Start the online auctions on April 22nd.
  - b. Donation form is in the final stages of editing for distribution to local businesses.
    - i. Fusing together multiple forms complete with the donation levels and perks for each level Bronze to Platinum.
    - ii. The Renaissance has donated 1 hour Bocce Ball for a group and \$75 food credit for auction.
    - iii. All donation items need to be in by April 15th.

- 1. All donors need to put the value and the description on their own items for clarity.
- 2. Boosters will use the back Conference room to store items for donation drop off.
- c. <u>www.betterworld.org</u> will be the same site used as last year for both ticket sales and auction items.
  - i. Tickets will be \$60 per person in advance and \$75 at the door. (If not sold out) AACT staff will get a BOGO ticket option.
    - Scott will be finding out the number cap from the Renaissance. (update - 175 is max to fit comfortably)
    - 2. Ticket price does not include drinks at the bar.
  - ii. Tickets will be able to be purchased via a link that will be sent out via email, and posted on all social media sites.
- d. Cost of the venue will be closer to \$8,300 with the original \$7,200 plus state sales tax and the cost for the PA system.
  - i. Mr. T will be tapped for the DJ position to help save costs for that.
  - ii. If room is available, incoming Freshmen parents will be invited to round out the 175 number.
    - 1. Final head count is due 2 weeks before the event to the Renaissance.
    - 2. Check will be cut for \$3,000 to hold the venue.
- e. Scott will be emailing teachers and Academy leads every 2 weeks to remind them to get ready for auctions with their baskets.
