- Student Report: Salem Neufeld for Leadership:

- Principal's Report:
 - -Prom

- -Students want it off site, with two possible outdoor locations being looked at for a discounted price of \$2500 with refundable \$500 deposit (Las Cascades or D'Andrea)

- Update post meeting: Mrs. Lee and Scott checked out both sites, and it looks like we are heavily leaning going with D'Andrea site it's still being built but will be ready by May (we only checked out Las Cascades as a reference D'Andrea will look similar but is in a much more awesome location directly overlooking the city and mountains and includes a barn wo there can be both inside/outside for the event)
