Increase core credit attainment (ELA, Math, Science) for 9th grade students with IEPs and LEP by 10% (from 43% for IEP and 58% for LEP).	Yes

The number of freshmen who demonstrated credit attainment in each core of ELA, Math, and Science is significantly higher than an overall credit attainment in all three areas. Currently, we do not have the data to inform us of the total percentage of credit attainments for all three areas combined. However, the percentage of credit attainment for each core area is moving us in the right direction.

successful in ELA, Alg 1, and Biology.
