Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act Notification

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) is a Federal Regulation which mandated all school districts to identify all building materials in their facilities which contain asbestos. As a result of this regulation, a Management Plan has been prepared for each facility identifying all asbestos containing building materials. The Management Plans are located in the central office of each facility and in the Regulated Systems Department of Facilities Management.

The AHERA regulation requires the District to notify all parent/teacher organizations of the Management Plans. Attached, please find Washoe County School District's official notification.

It is requested that you announce this notification at your next meeting. Additionally, please publish the notice "as is" in your next newsletter.

## WASHOE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT MANAGEMENT PLAN NOTIFICATION

On October 22, 1986, the President of the United States, signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) to CFR 763. AHERA requires all school districts throughout the United States, including Washoe County School District, to inspect their schools for asbestos and to develop a Management Plan which identified the location of all asbestos in each school.

A requirement of AHERA is that Washoe County School District is to notify the public annually that these Management Plans are available for review in each school's main office.
