I can't believe it's already November. That went by fast! I want to give everyone a quick update on what the Galena Five Star Boosters Board has been up to:

- We've given the Strategies class \$1500 to purchase supplies. We've donated \$350 in gift cards for staff incentives. And, we're actively soliciting teachers and staff for other needed items that benefit the entire Galena community.
- The Senior Activities Committee helped out with Senior Sunrise and sponsored an ice cream truck for the Class of 2023. They're also organizing a Trunk or Treat for Seniors, along with planning a Senior Lunch for November.

2022 NIAA Fall Season State Academic Team Champions



The NIAA also recognizes those varsity student-athletes who achieved a 4.0 GPA the previous semester by naming them to the All-State Academic Team. The team grade point average is determined by taking the individual GPA's of varsity team members from last semester and then computing an overall average.

The NIAA and Jostens, the NIAA's awards partner, consider this state academic championship Award to be equal to the athletic championship award. As the NIAA, coaches and administrators should always stress, the participants are students first, then athletes.

Counseling Corner

Happy November Grizzlies! We are past the mid-point in the first semester already- December is right around the corner! Remember: Only *final* semester report card grades are reported on the transcript. If you presently have some low grades, you still have time to improve those grades before the semester ends next month. But do not delay on getting any low grades brought up!

- Communicating with your teachers is the first and most important step to start improving your grades.
- Ask them what you can do to get your grade up and when you can come in for extra help (lunch, before or after school, etc.).
- Your teachers are here to help you, but it is up to you to be proactive, advocate for yourself, and take advantage of the help offered to you.
- We understand that this can be a little bit intimidating and we are more than happy to help facilitate the process of getting your student extra help....so please, do not hesitate to ask!

The second semester will end in June. Remember: the December and June final grades are the 'permanent' ones. Parents should have access to student grades, attendance, and assignments on Infinite Campus. If you have not logged into Infinite Campus yet or are having problems logging in, please contact Dana Leslie in our main office at extension 30511. Please continue to regularly monitor your student's progress so that any difficulties or problems can be addressed immediately!

Some reminders to ALL of our students (especially seniors!):

- Please visit the College and Career Center often for all things related to financial aid, scholarships, college admissions, career planning, options 'after high school', and much, much more!
- Ms. Applebach in our Career Center is a tremendous resource for all our students and is ready to help you.
- Information is also posted on the Galena College and Career website.
- Seniors: be aware of those scholarships, financial aid, FAFSA, and college application deadlines right now and over the course of the next several months!!

In addition to staying on top of your classes this year (remember: the goal is graduation, and it starts by passing your classes!), students can also explore the various ways to get involved in your school and/or community. Be sure to listen to the announcements each day for more information on activities here at Galena (announcements are also posted on our website). One thing to keep in mind as you start to explore extracurricular options is that it is often more advantageous and rewarding to be dedicated and involved in those activities that you really enjoy (i.e. soccer team, volunteering with a program, etc.) than to have a bunch of activities that you started and eventually quit or gave only a slight bit of time and attention to.

Students should consider starting a folder/list called "Things to Brag About" (or even a personal resume).

- List and file away all of the activities, sports, clubs, volunteering, etc., that you are involved in.
- Also include any awards/recognitions you receive and be sure to update it regularly.
- This list will come in very handy when you are filling out college and scholarship applications!

Ultimately, participate in those sports, activities, and/or clubs that you love, are interested in, and can dedicate yourself to while keeping your grades up and not creating huge amounts of stress. Sometimes this can result in a balancing act and figuring how to successfully balance academics and extracurricular activities is a lifelong learning process! In the end, however, it is not about "how long the list is" of activities that you were involved in that is important; rather it is the level of involvement and commitment that you invested (and hopefully had fun too!). As the saying goes: it is about quality, not quantity!

Keep working hard Grizzlies and stay focused! The December "end of semester" finish line is almost here. We are here to help you, so please contact us with any questions or concerns. Here's to a strong finish to the first semester Grizzlies- you got this!

From the College and Career Center

Hello from the Career Center. I hope everyone is enjoying the fall colors and cooler weather. The Career Center just finished celebrating College Week. The WACAC hosted colleges at the Reno Convention Center and I hope many families were able to attend. November is when a lot of schools have their priority deadlines or final deadline to apply. It is important to know the specific dates for each school you are interested in so that you do not miss out.

We have been offering FAFSA workshops for our students and families to attend to help submit the application. The application opened October 1st, so we encourage students to submit their application as soon as possible. Please review the Career Center website for all the workshop dates and to register. You can attend any workshop at any of the High Schools in the Washoe County School District. I am posting scholarships as they come across my desk to our TEAMS class and on the career center website for you to review. If you have any questions regarding the application, letters of reference or essay prompts, please email or see me.

Many students have had questions about transcripts. All transcripts must be ordered through https://washoeschoolsnv.scriborder.com The school is no longer allowed to give unofficial or official transcripts to students. You must order through this website, your first (4) transcripts are free. You have the option of mailing a sealed transcript or uploading an electronic version of one. Please remember to allow for processing and plan accordingly.

If you have been accepted to your school of choice, make sure you review your student account with the school.

- Many will be requesting your shot records, opening their in-house scholarships, asking for applications to be filled out for housing, and requesting transcripts.
- If you are in the Jump Start Program taking college classes or have passed AP tests with a score of 3, 4, or 5, remember to submit your AP test scores as well as your transcripts from your school.
- Schools will need this information to waive classes and give you college credits. If you are attending a Nevada post-secondary school, you can order your transcript for free.
- If you are attending out of state, please use the Transcript Request from the National Student Clearinghouse. Visit here for both https://tsorder.studentclearinghouse.org/school/welcome
