

Athletic News

We'd like to congratulate all of our athletes on an incredible Fall season thus far. Go Grizz! And, we'd like to remind our Winter athletes that physical examinations are required every two years for every athlete and spirit team members. Make your appointment now as many Doctor's offices tend to fill up. The forms that the physician must use are available at Galena High School main office, or you may download the physical forms at <u>www.NIAA.com</u> (click on NIAA Forms, Forms B and D).

- Pre-Participation History Form Completed as a new athlete or when an existing physical has expired
- NIAA Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form (Typically needed 1st and 3rd Year) Physicals are required every two years



Counseling Corner

Happy October Grizzlies! We are at the midpoint of the first semester already- hard to believe it's here! A few reminders: the grade report that comes home at this point is a "progress report". Know that progress report grades are not reflected on the "final" high school transcript. Only *final* semester report card grades are reported on the transcript. If your progress report has low grades, you still have time to improve those grades before the semester ends in December. The second semester will end in June. As we always emphasize to students- the December and June final grades are the 'permanent' ones!

The counselors have just wrapped up visiting all the English classrooms (each grade level) to provide students with detailed information on their credit status, diploma types, general credit/high school information, and various "post" high school, college, and career information resources.

SENIORS: you should be actively and consistently reviewing Ms. Applebach's Teams channel so you can stay on top of financial aid, college, and scholarship application updates. We are heading directly into the 'college application deadline' season and we are here to support students as they navigate this deadline-filled time!

- Staying organized and on top of each deadline is key to making sure you do not miss any critical deadlines and feeling more prepared and ready.
- The College and Career Center website, along with the Galena Counseling website, contains valuable information and resources to assist you in this process.
- Ms. Applebach in the College and Career Center and your counselors are here to support you so don't hesitate to reach out if you have any questions!

Now that we are halfway through the semester, students often know what classes (if any) that they are struggling in. We always encourage our students to reach out first to their teachers for additional support and guidance. Galena has a team of fantastic teachers who are more than willing to provide extra help and support to students, but the student must be willing to ask for help and take advantage of the extra help offered. **Many teachers are available at lunch and either before and/or after school (students should check with their individual teachers). The 7th period Academic Success class is also a valuable opportunity for students to get assistance.**

- Parents should have access to student grades, attendance, and assignments on Infinite Campus.
- If you have not logged into Infinite Campus yet or are having problems logging in, please contact Dana Leslie in our main office at extension 30511.
- Please continue to regularly monitor your student's progress so that any difficulties or problems can be addressed immediately!

At Galena, academics is our number one priority; however, we absolutely do encourage you to help your student maintain a balance of fun activities and school-related responsibilities. Hopefully your student is learning more about some of the clubs, sports and student organizations that Galena has to offer. If your student would like to start a club, have them check in with us and we can point them in the appropriate direction for more information. The more a student becomes involved and connected with school-related activities, quite often school becomes a more positive experience.

FASFA: The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application opens **OCTOBER 1.** If you are interested in submitting FAFSA attend our **FAFSA Workshop October 12th from 6-8pm in the library.** Financial Aid Representatives from UNR and TMCC will be here to help guide you through the application process. You do not need to be applying to TMCC or UNR to attend—it is for everyone. Can't make this date? No problem. WCSD has coordinated FAFSA nights at each of the high schools during October and November. You can attend any FAFSA workshop at any of the schools. Registration is required. The sign-up link/QR code can be found on the College/Career Center website. <u>College and Career Center / Homepage</u> (washoeschools.net) or around the school on the bulletin boards. You apply for FAFSA each year you attend school. There are many grants and scholarships available for students and you will not know if you are eligible unless you apply.

Career Lunches: We had our first Career Lunch on September 15th. Several businesses visited with students during lunch which included a REMSA Ambulance and a local logistics company that provided a lift operating forklift. **Our future Career lunches are scheduled for 10/20 and 11/9**. Our Galena J4NG students will be hosting and presenting the career lunch on 10/20 so come visit and support our programs. There will be organizations including Military, Entrepreneurs, Panasonic, Medical Skills for Life, Aviation Experts, Washoe County Human Development and much more. Come learn about different careers.

Nevada Promise Scholarship: If you are a senior and considering attending a community college in Nevada, please apply for the Nevada Promise scholarship. If you complete the mandatory steps by their scheduled deadline, you could be eligible for up to 3 years tuition and mandatory registration fees waived. **The deadline to apply is October 31**st. Remember, your application for the Nevada Promise Scholarship is separate from your application to your Nevada community college of choice.

Are you interested in taking the ASVAB? The ASVAB stands for the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery, a standardized test used to rate an individual's aptitude in the areas of science, math, and language. **Sign up at the counseling office if you are interested in taking the test on 10/18/22 at Galena.**
