Counseling Corner

Welcome Back Grizzlies! The school year is off and running and hopefully you are settling in and having a good time at Galena High School! We are getting close to the middle of the first semester already. The grade report that comes home at nine weeks is a "progress report". Progress report grades are <u>not</u> reflected on the "final" high school transcript. Only semester report card grades are reported on the transcript. If your progress report has low grades, you still have time to improve those grades before the semester ends in December. The second semester will end in June. Remember: December + June = when grades go on your official transcript! **The last day to add a class for credit is September 12th**, and the last day to withdraw from a class without penalty of an "F" on the transcript is November 4th; however, it is too late to 'add' a class at that time. Please contact your counselor if you have any questions or need clarification.

We believe one of the most important things for all students is getting into a routine of getting schoolwork done in a timely manner and not missing any assignments or homework. Over and over, it can be shown that students who have all assignments completed do better on quizzes and tests. Also, we cannot stress enough the importance of attendance. At Galena, academics is our number one priority; however, we absolutely encourage you to help your student maintain a balance of fun activities and school-related responsibilities. Hopefully your student is learning more about some of the sports and student organizations that Galena has to offer. The more a student becomes involved and connected with school-related activities, quite often school becomes a more positive experience!

Now that the semester is underway, students and parents may reach out because they are struggling in a particular class. Our first question is (almost!) always "Have you talked with your teacher about your concerns?" The most common answer we get is "no." Galena has a team of fantastic teachers who are more than willing to provide extra help and support to students, but the student must be willing to ask for help and take advantage of the extra help offered. Many teachers are available at lunch and either before and/or after school (students should check with their individual teachers). We understand that high school can be a little bit intimidating and we are more than happy to help facilitate the process of getting your student extra help!

If you have not logged into Infinite Campus yet or are having problems logging in, please contact Dana Leslie in our main office. Please continue to regularly monitor your student's progress so that any difficulties or problems can be addressed immediately!
