Celebrations

- Congratulations to our National Merit Scholarship Finalists: Mathew Long and Jake Webber!
- Camp Grizz was an overwhelming success on March 10th with over 300 8th grade students visiting Galena for the 1st time.
- A cohort of Galena students are working with the WCSD Student Voice Department during 7th period Academic Success to identify areas in the Curriculum and Culture of the school to increase student engagement. Several of the Galena students presented at the "State of Education" press conference on March 31st.
- Mrs. Tennile O'Meara was selected as the "Northern Nevada Social Studies Teacher of the Year!" Mrs. O'Meara and the Galena "We the People" team made it to the State competition in just their first year at Galena.

Graduation 2022 information

- Each student will receive 10 tickets and 3 parking passes
- We will begin with Senior talks in May during which we will explain the Graduation Attire guidelines, Graduation Practice dates, and procedures for the Graduation Ceremony itself.

This is a busy time of year for our juniors and seniors. Juniors recently took the ACT test and once scores are sent out, students will start receiving postcards and letters from colleges. This is a great time for juniors to start researching colleges and visiting them over the summer. Many schools will have tours available for prospective students which is always a great way to learn more about the school. For students looking out of state, the Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE) is a great way to save money on tuition while going to school outside Nevada.

Lately, we have been announcing many programs for students interested in vocational schools. TESLA, Renown Health, TMCC all have specialized cohort programs that offer students the opportunity to learn while being paid. Some of these programs are for students that have graduated, and some are for Juniors heading into their senior year.
