Happy New Year! We hope the Winter Break was restful and joyous for all. If you are new to Galena this year, then you need to know that February is an important month for our students and families. Here's some things you will want to know:

- Students started receiving information on Course Selection for the 23-24 school year in the last two weeks of January.
- Students will choose Academic Courses in February for the 23-24 school year.
- Counselors will work with students and families to select the best courses for each student based on goals.

Additionally, we pride ourselves on hiring, training, and retaining the best teaching staff in the District. Over the course of the past two years with the pandemic, rezoning, retirements, and other staff shifting, we have struggled to maintain the necessary numbers of highly qualified instructors. However, we've diligently maintained relationships with the College of Education at UNR, Grand Canyon University, Western Governors University, and have found some wonderful Student Interns who are making their teaching debut this Spring at Galena, and we hope to keep them on the staff for the next year.

Galena is growing! Our projected student number for next year is 1304. This equates to 43 Certified Teaching allocations. This is partially good news, however, for the past 2 years, we've been allocated 44.5 teachers that were supported by Federal ESSERS Grant funding: That funding has expired, and we will be losing 1.5 teachers for next year. Therefore, we are looking at some alternative options to keep the teachers we've brought to Galena at Galena.

FEBRUARY 1ST COMMUNITY OPEN HOUSE AT GALENA HIGH SCHOOL-VARIANCES AVAILABLE!!!

The "Open House" is a combined informational opportunity for students and families new to Galena to learn about our school, or for those existing families and students to ask questions about programs directly from the teachers, coaches, and administrators. This night is a combination of the previous AP/College Night, 8th Grade Parent Night, CTE/STEM Nights, etc.

If you have friends or family who are looking for an amazing small school for their students, we are looking to bring some students in on variances for the 23-24 school year. Hello Galena families and staff,

We are more than half way through the school year and we want to thank everyone who has become a member of the 5 Star Boosters/PTO, renewed your membership and/or contributed to our No Fundraiser, Fundraiser. We are extremely grateful for your contributions.

Here's just a few examples of how we've been able to use your contributions this year:

- We've given the Galena Den \$1500 for the purchase of a Cricket and press. It will be used to create Galena t-shirts that will be given out as rewards and to increase school spirit. Leadership will also be able to use the equipment to create class t-shirts. We've given the Strategies class \$1500 to purchase supplies. We've donated \$350 in gift cards for staff incentives. 

Greetings Grizzlies,

We have officially entered Testing Season! Second semester is chock full of various assessments that different groups of students will be participating in at various times. Please check the <u>rSchoolToday Calendar</u> on the school website for specific dates of upcoming tests. In January we began **ACCESS** testing for English Language Learners which will extend through March 1st. The window for the **CTE End-of-Program Exams** is from February 6th through March 17th. Your child's CTE teacher will have specific dates for your child's test if they are in one of these programs.

March 7th will be **ACT testing** for ALL Juniors and Seniors that did not take it last year. **Only these students will attend school on this date.** Freshman, sophomores, and seniors(that have already tested) will **NOT** attend school on this day. The **Civics Exam** which is a graduation requirement for all graduating seniors will be available from February 1st through March 17th. Please contact your child's Government or Economics teacher for more information. If your graduating senior is not currently enrolled in a Gov/Econ class and has NOT taken the Civics Exam, please reach out to his or her counselor for assistance.

Finally, the **NV Science Exam** for 9th and 10th graders will be in April and **AP Exams** will be in May. Again, keep checking the **rSchoolToday Calendar** for exact dates. If you have any questions regarding testing, please email A. Redd at <u>Antoinette.redd@washoeschools.net</u>

Counseling Corner

Greetings Grizzlies! Despite the cold and wintry weather, it will be spring very soon and with that comes only a few months remaining in the 2022-23 school year!

- Counselors have provided all students (grades 9-11) with the course selection materials for the 23-24 school year via their English class.
- They will be meeting individually with students in February to review their seven (7) course selections for next year (students have been advised to secure a parent signature on their course selection forms!)
- If your student has questions, they are welcome to visit their counselor during lunch or nutrition break, and counselors are also accessible via email
- All course requests will be in our database by the end of February in order to build next year's master schedule, so it is critical that we have accurate course requests.
- You must register your student for the 2023-24 school year. Registration does not renew automatically.

The end of the 3rd quarter grading period is March 17th. The 9-week report card is just a progress report and is not part of your student's permanent high school transcript. At this point in time, we do not have any specific information or details on summer school; however, please stay tuned.

If a student is short on credits, he/she needs to explore a plan for recovery immediately.

- Please contact your counselor so they can review those options (specifically BYU Correspondence and/or Edgenuity) with you and your student. BYU Independent Studies and Edgenuity are online options.
- Please note online coursework is not necessarily accepted at every college (or the NCAA Clearinghouse) and online coursework is not always the "best fit" for every student.

Spring is also a great time to start thinking about and planning any family vacations. You might want to include a college visit if your travels take you close to a college campus. It is never too early to start gathering college information and researching options. Most colleges run campus tours all summer long. Many colleges offer summer programs for high school students. These are typically of an academic nature and offer an opportunity to experience college "life" firsthand while potentially earning some type of academic credit. Most of these programs do require a financial commitment.

One last reminder: check Infinite Campus regularly. Do not wait to seek help. If you have not accessed Infinite Campus or are having difficulty accessing it, please contact Dana Leslie in our main office at <u>DLeslie@washoeschools.net</u>. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions or concerns. In the meantime, with only a few months left, please encourage your student to keep working hard and finish the year strong- it really does count. Academic success (and earning all your credits!) sets the stage for a positive and successful outcome for graduation!

It's hard to believe the senior year is already halfway done! Graduation will be here before we know it. **The final semester grades from December are already reflected on your student's transcript**. Colleges will be seeing these grades; it's critical that your student's academic performance does not decline during either semester of their senior year, or it may jeopardize an admissions decision and/or merit scholarships! *All college acceptances are "conditional" based on 7th and final semester transcripts meeting that college's requirements.* "Senioritis" is common but must be overcome to achieve graduation in June!

When applying to colleges, OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS are required; many schools also require a Mid-Year Report and most schools demand a Final Transcript, as all admissions are contingent upon the student finishing high school successfully. Most students know this and already sent official transcripts, but if you don't here is what you can do:

- Go to the school website, <u>www.washoeschools.net/Galena</u> and look under QUICK LINKS on the bottom.
- Select "Order transcripts" then click "current student".
- When you get down to "Delivery Address" (blue on right) select "Educational Institution" in the dropdown and then start typing the name of college(s) and it will fill in the address when selected.
- Green boxes: For COLLEGE and OFFICIAL HS TRANSCRIPT. You get four transcripts for free, so once you initial and sign it, the fee will disappear on the first four.

The Millennium Scholarship

The Millennium Scholarship is based on eight semesters of academic work; students who finish the course requirements, have lived in Nevada for two years and achieve a weighted cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 by graduation will be put on a Millennium Scholarship List by our Registrar which is sent to the Nevada Treasurer's office after graduation. ACT composite of 21 or SAT of 1070 also qualifies a student. There is no application, qualifying Galena graduates will receive a letter from the Nevada Treasurer in July and it will be up to the student to go onto the website, register and indicate which Nevada institution they are attending in the fall. Typically, funds are deposited a week before classes begin.

Class of 2023

This spring will be full of fun senior activities. Please listen to announcements and watch your Class of 2023 TEAMS class for updates. There will be forms to fill out to receive a senior banner, submit your scholarship offers for the Senior Awards Night and finalizing post-graduation plans. **Our Senior Awards Recognition Event will be May 30th at the Atlantis Resort Casino Spa.** This event is where we honor seniors with class awards, community service awards, academic awards and scholarship offers that are submitted to the Career Center. We will announce and list all scholarship offers that are submitted that evening and in the graduation program. Only the scholarship NAME is listed, we do not announce or print monetary values. Seniors will have the month of March and April to submit all scholarships they want announced. Please keep watching the scholarship page on the College and Career Center website for more information about scholarships being posted and due dates. Apply, Apply, Apply! I am here to support all grade levels at Galena High School, so please stop by or let me know how I can help.
