## Community

Washoe County School District serves the educational needs of the greater Washoe County, Nevada. Washoe County encompasses the Reno area and extends as far north as Wadsworth, Nevada, south to Washoe Valley, and west to Lake Tahoe, where Incline Village is located. Currently, the district consists of 16 high schools, 15 middle schools and 60 elementary schools utilizing a K-5, 6-8, 9-12 grade-level configuration. Washoe County has one on-line K-12 school.

## Incline High School

Incline Village, Nevada has one comprehensive high school. Incline High School is a four-year public high school enrolling 302 students in grades 9-12. The school opened in the fall of 1968 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1969. Incline High was accredited by **Advanced in 2016**. Incline's 2017- 2018 Accountability Report demographic information reports 41% of its population Hispanic, 54% white, and 4% two or more races.

## Curriculum

The **academic program** is organized on a rotating block schedule. Seven, half credits per semester is the minimum course load until senior year; students take six 100-minute block classes and one 50-minute class. Students attend three block classes and the 50 minute class daily. Block classes are year-long; each block class meets every other day. There are two semesters in a year for a total of 7 credits possible per year. The 50 minute class is designed to enrich students in college and post high school skills or is a support class for students' classes and/or in skills attainment.

**These AP® courses** are offered: Studio Art: Drawing, Art 2D and 3D Design, Calculus AB and BC, Computer Science, Biology, English Language and Composition, English Literature, Environmental Science, Human Geography, Music Theory, Physics 1, Physics B and C , United States Government and Politics: We the People, and United States History. AP World Language and Culture courses offered include: French and Spanish as well as Spanish Literature. AP Research was added last year to add to AP Seminar for the complete AP Capstone Program. **AP is an open- enrollment program but teacher referral is required.**

**Honors classes** are offered in Algebra II (STEM), Art (third year), Jazz and Concert Band (third and fourth years), Biology, Chemistry, English I, English II, Formal Geometry, H.R.O.T.C (third and fourth years), and Trigonometry/Pre-Calculus. Also offered are French and Spanish (third year).

**At the present time Incline offers World Geography, AP Human Geography, U.S. History, AP U.S. History, Government and AP Government and Politics in our social studies department.**

Students are able and encouraged to earn college credits at local institutions of higher education through Dual Credit opportunities that are offered at Sierra Nevada College, Truckee Meadows Community College, the University of Nevada, Reno and Western Nevada College.

## Grading and Ranking

**A – Excellent                    90–100% = 4.0**

**B – Above average            80–90% = 3.0**

## Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

GPA is computed in all subjects using the above quality points from grade nine. A minimum of 22.5 credits is **required for graduation**. Students earning the Advanced Diploma have completed 24 credits, 4 years of Math, 3 of Science and attained a GPA of 3.25. Students earning Honors Diploma have completed the requirements for an Advanced Diploma, attained a 3.4 GPA, lab sciences for 2 of 3 science credits, 8 full years of honors and or AP credits and 2 years of the same foreign language. **Honors classes are weighted by 0.025 and AP classes are weighted by 0.05.** Grades are recorded on the transcript, and GPA and ranking are computed in January and in June. Washoe County School District offers a Career Technical Education endorsement on the diploma upon successfully completing 3 years of the same technical classes, a college readiness test and a test of skills. We offer a Seal of Bi-Literacy endorsement upon completing passing scores on the APPL test, or successful completion of an AP language test. Students must receive a 3.0 average in 4 years of English classes for the Seal of Bi-Literacy.

There were **61** graduates in the Class of 2018.

## Advanced Placement Results

- In May 2018, 119 of Incline students took AP Exams
- A total of 245 exams were taken in 20 subjects
- 65% of the AP Exams taken received scores of 3 or higher
- 34 students achieved AP SCHOLAR status: 15 AP Scholars, 4 with honor, 15 AP with Distinction, and **2 National AP scholars.**
- 6 AP Seminar and Research Certificates and 16 Capstone Diplomas were awarded

## Post High School Placement

- 66% of graduates, matriculated to 4-year colleges
- 27% of graduates, matriculated to 2-year institutions or trade schools
- 7% of graduates, elected work, military service or service programs (as a Gap Year).
