### SWIM TEAM 5<sup>th</sup> at REGIONALS:

The Combined Team received the Team Sportsmanship Award this year and Coach Megan received "Coach of the Year" Honors.

Sequoia Denton opened the Regional meet by singing the National Anthem and both the Incline Boys and Girls Teams took 5th in the Region this Year.

- Athletes swam 100% personal best times in this meet
- The boys team took Second in the 200 yard Medley Relay (Liam Jones, Nick Finne, Andrew Bilotti, Ben Rock)

- Senior, Nick Finne finished 6th in both the 200 yard Individual Medley and the 100 yard Breastroke, improving on both of his times.
- Andrew Bilotti took first in both the 200 yard freestyle and the 500 yard freestyle with a 1:47.62 and 4;54.27 respectively. **Both times broke** school records.
- Sophomore, Shannon Hugar took 6th place in the 50 yard Freestyle and 8th in the 100 yard backstroke
- Liam Jones finished 5th in the 100 yard fly and 4th in the 100 yard backstroke
- Ava Winter swam the 100 yard breaststroke, finishing 7th with a time improvement of 5.66 seconds
- Madison Racich, Sequoia Denton, Abby Duckworth and Samantha Martinez-Urzua finished 4th in the 200 yard freestyle relay
- Freshman, Abby Duckworth finished 6th in the 500 yard freestyle cutting 31.30 seconds off of her seed time.
- In the 400 yard Freestyle Relay, Liam Jones, Ben Rock, Nick Fine and Andrew Bilotti placed 3rd with a time of 4:03.67
