PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE

TARDIES

Timeliness is held in high regard as it is everyone's responsibility to contribute to teaching and learning environments that are uninterrupted.

EMI – Excused missed instruction (Medical per parent or excused by school staff)

UMI – Unexcused missed instruction (slept late, missed bus, late ride to school...)

- **More than 10 minutes late** to class = automatic lunch detention
- *2 total UMI's / semester without consequence (*includes ALL classes)
- **2nd – 7th period tardies**
 - 3 - 7 total = **LUNCH DETENTIONS**
 - 8 - 9 total = **AFTER SCHOOL DETENTIONS**
 - 10th tardy = **LOSS OF OFF CAMPUS & assigned to meet w/ Site Council**
- **1st period tardies**
 - 10 total = **4 LUNCH DETENTIONS**
 - 11 - 15 total = **LUNCH DETENTIONS**
 - 16-19 total = **AFTER SCHOOL DETENTIONS**
 - 20 total = **LOSS OF OFF CAMPUS**
 - Earn back LOOC privilege with 15 consecutive days of no 1st period tardies
 - 21 total = **AFTER SCHOOL DETENTIONS & assigned to meet w/ Site Council**

DRESS CODE

Students should dress appropriately for a professional learning environment.

- Alternate clothing immediately provided if students violate dress code
- Detentions issued after 2 dress code violations / semester

TECHNOLOGY

Class time – personal devices used with teacher permission only.

Passing time – only 1 ear bud at a time as a safety rule to enable students to hear adult directives.

All technology violations result in immediate confiscation by the teacher.

| 1st Violation = | device returned at end of class |
| 2nd Violation = | student pick up from office at end of the day |
| 3rd Violation = | parent pick up from office (hours 7am – 3:30pm) |
| 4th Violation = | parent conference, **device banned for rest of semester |

**If school issued laptop is confiscated, student will be issued a laptop as needed for specific classes.

SITE COUNCIL

Composed of administration & teacher representation, will meet 2x/month.

Students will be assigned to meet with the council to determine individual consequences.

INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR / ACADEMIC INTEGRITY, PLAGARISM

Consequences – based on course policies and procedures, may include, but not limited to:

- Removal from class for the period
- Lunch Detention
- Parent Contact
- After School Detention
- Loss of Off-Campus Privilege
- In-School-Suspension (ISS)
- Saturday School
- Out of School Suspension

CLOSED CAMPUS / LOSS OF PRIVILEGE

Students NOT in good standing required to remain on campus at lunch – may include lunch detentions below 2.0 GPA (*NIAA Eligibility*) – can earn back at quarter

3 minor behaviors (dress code, technology, inappropriate behavior)

1 Major Behavior (suspension)

10 or more Total tardies (2nd – 7th period) OR 20 Total tardies 1st period

LUNCH DETENTION

Daily, 20 min, THEATER

NO Technology, NO Talking, NO sitting together

AFTER SCHOOL DETENTION

Mon, Tues, Thurs, 2:20 – 3:20pm, office

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SATURDAY SCHOOL

Monthly, 9am – 12pm

Some Behaviors Can Result In Immediate Expulsion / Permanent Removal From School

Possession of deadly weapon on campus

Selling of controlled or illegal substances on campus

Violence to staff or students

Persistent and pervasive bullying or harassment

ATTENDANCE

- **4 or more** unexcused absences = Automatic Failure!!! (8 unexcused for 1st period) = *NRS 392.122*
- **ALL absences unexcused until work is made-up!** *Same as snow day policy!*

SCHOOL SAFETY

- **EVACUATIONS During Passing Time** – Exit building immediately, meet with your 1st period teacher
 - o No 1st period class? Meet in front of school with Mrs. Brown (librarian)
- **SINGLE POINT ENTRY** – after 7:35am, all doors will be locked except front entrance
 - o 3rd floor doors may be propped open during lunch only
- **OFF CAMPUS / NO SCHEDULED CLASS** – students must sign and follow *Off Campus* guidelines
 - o If staying on campus = must be in a location with a sign-in sheet (library, office), No loitering
- **PERSONAL PROPERTY** – lockers should be used. Items should NOT be left in halls.
 - o Incline HS & WCSD are not responsible for lost items.

PARKING

- Parking Permits for on-campus parking = \$2 each, purchased in office, must show valid license
