ATTENTION SENIORS: During the academic year, the federal government provides billions of dollars to students in the way of loans, grants and work study programs.

First visit www.STUDENTAID.ED.GOV, to learn all about the financial aid process, from pre-college to repayment. To apply for financial aid, students must fill out the **2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid** (FAFSA) as soon as possible After October 1, 2018.

- FAFSA on the Web is a Fast, **Free**, secure and Easy way to apply for federal aid. Access the **application at www.fafsa.gov**
- While students are encouraged to apply ONLINE, paper applications are available by calling the Federal Student Aid Information Center at 1-800-433-3243
- **PIN** Obtain your by visiting <https://fsaid.ed.gov>
- **Students** and **Parents** need to obtain their own PINs which are used to electronically sign the FAFSA application. **GUARD your PIN.** You will use this PIN each year to File a FAFSA.
- Prepare by completing the FAFSA ON THE Web Worksheet.

- You will need to have filed your **2017** taxes. During the application, FAFSA will ask to directly download your numbers via the IRS website.
- The FAFSA is available in Spanish. Both Spanish and English directions are available.
- Parents must have completed their **2017** Federal taxes to the complete application.

Be sure you **make a copy** of your completed FAFSA for your records.

Do not pay money to submit your application to the Office of Federal Student Aid, U.S. Department of Education. The application is **FREE**.

Students who are undocumented can fill out a UNR **Estimated Family Contribution** document. Please see Ms. Haddad for the application in Spanish and English. This EFC can only be used by students for the Incline Scholarship and UNR Application.
