Grades For Achievement And Citizenship:

4 = \$+	Transforming/Exceeds Standard Indicates the student is demonstrating skills beyond what is expected for their current grade level.
3 = \$	Performing/Meets Standard Indicates the student is demonstrating skills at what is expected for their current grade level.
2.5 = S-	Developing/Approaching Standard Indicates the student is demonstrating skills <i>approaching</i> what is expected for their current grade level.
1 = 1	Emerging/Below Standard Indicates the student is demonstrating skills below what is expected for their current grade level.

In Infinite Campus you will see both percentages and letter grades. Infinite Campus percentages can be confusing as we typically equate percentages with traditional letter grades (A-F). If a student receives a 3 on an assignment, the percentage shows up as a 75%. This is not equivalent to the traditional C, but rather an S, meaning they are meeting the grade level standard.

Performances:

Mark your calendar! Each student will perform in a grade level concert this year to celebrate what they are learning in music. We also invite families to observe and participate in music classes March 6 – 10! Individual class performance times and reminders will be sent home as we approach each concert date.
