

Good Evening Brown Families,

I have a couple of reminders I wanted to share with all of you:

- **In Building:**
 - If you drop off and pick up your students:
 - There is no stopping or parking in the red zone on Western Skies.
 - This is a very busy street, we have a crosswalk duty person on duty to help students cross from 9:15-9:30 and 3:30/2:45 on Wednesdays.
 - It is not safe to park and drop off students to the back gate to the playground on Western Skies. Please continue to drop off students at the front of the school where the traffic is much slower and safer.
 - There is no parking in the red zone on Reading Way, this is marked off red to ensure the school busses can turn around and safety for those walking across Reading Way to get to their vehicles.
 - When leaving the Brown ES parking lot if you turn right to exit, please double check to ensure there are no students crossing the exit late before you turn.
 - Thank you for continuing to follow our safety rules.
- **Distance Learning:**
 - Please remember that when our students are on screen with their teacher, they are 'in class' and in their learning environment. If you have a question for your teacher, please dojo, email, or set up a zoom meeting with your teacher to resolve any questions or concerns. Our teachers always communicate within 24 hours. Interrupting zoom lessons to ask personal questions takes away from all students and their learning.

(repeat) 21-22 Online Registration:

- Online Registration is now open for the 21-22 School Year
- Registration needs to be completed through your **infinite campus parent portal**.
- If you do not know your log in information, or if you are having difficulties registering your child please contact our office.
- **We do ask that if you are experiencing issues, please do not create a new student profile for your child.**
- If you have an incoming kinder student you will add them with your existing child's online registration.
 - While in the registration process you will see a tab marked other household.
 - If your incoming child is **not** listed in this section you may continue to the next page and add them as a new student under the "Student" tab
 - If your incoming child is listed in this section beside your child's name there is a blue edit box. Simply click on the edit box and at the bottom you will check mark the white box that says you are registering this student for the incoming school year.

(repeat) 21/22 Proof of Residency:

- Proof of residency will be accepted as of February 8th
- We will need a current utility bill (Or any bill) received through the US Mail brought to the office.
- Please have proof of residency by **May 7th**.
 - You can have your student bring it with them to school, they can bring it to the office, we'll make a copy and return to your student.
- Students will not be assigned a class for next year until registration is complete and proof of residency is received.
- Kinder registration times to bring in paperwork is 10:30am – 2:30pm weekdays.
- Just a reminder, due to the new apartments/condo's and housing developments scheduled to be completed, I will not be taking any student variances for the 2021-2022 school year.
- **If your child's online registration is complete and we have received proof of residency by February 19th your student will receive a special prize.**
