What Families Need to Know:

- New menu options will roll out throughout the year, with student feedback guiding choices.
- Meal prices may increase slightly, in line with federal USDA guidelines. This increase may be as little as ten cents The current price for lunch is \$3.25
- WCSD policy ensures that no child will be refused a meal or otherwise shamed due to lack of ability to pay.
- Families will still use **MySchoolBucks** to manage meal payments.
- Families must reapply for Free & Reduced-Price Lunch (FRL) for the 2025–26 school year, unless your child attends a school participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). The application opens in fall: washoeschools.net/mealapplication.
- There will be no job losses for WCSD school-based Nutrition Services employees—your familiar cafeteria staff will still be here to serve your students.
