Afraid you won't be able to afford your child's school-required vaccines?

The federally-funded Vaccines For Children (VFC) program provides free or low-cost vaccines to children younger than 19 years old who are uninsured, underinsured, Medicaid-eligible, American Indian or Alaskan Native.

"Underinsured" children who have health insurance that does not cover vaccination can receive VFC vaccines through select health centers. Please call provider offices first to schedule an appointment.

Requirements for School Vaccines in Nevada

Kindergartners and other children enrolling in a Nevada school for the first time must provide schools with an official Immunization Record showing that the child has received the required number of doses of Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTap); Polio (IPV); Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR); Hepatitis A; Hepatitis B; and Varicella (Chicken Pox).

Students entering 7th grade must have been vaccinated with the Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Acellular Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine and the Quadrivalent Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV4 or MenACWY) vaccine.

A flu vaccine is recommended annually for everyone 6 months and older, and 11-12 year olds are also recommended to receive the HPV vaccine.
