Attendance at School is Important for your Child's Success!

ON TRACK – Students are more likely to be on track if they attend at least 90% of the school year.

DON'T MISS – All absences, whether excused or unexcused, impact a student's learning.

IT ADDS UP – Missing just two days a month will result in your child being chronically absent by the end of the year + 18 days of missed school.

IN SCHOOL EVERY DAY – Every day is an opportunity to learn, build relationships and access supports.

What Can I Do to Support my child or teenager with Attendance?

TALK – Talk to your child early on about why school is important to you.

ROUTINE – Creating a daily routine at home to attend school can reduce stress for students and create a sense of safety.

PLAN AHEAD – If you planned a vacation during the 180 school days, ask your teachers for make-up work.

ASK FOR HELP – If your family is faced with challenges regarding childcare, transportation, or other barriers, please communicate with school staff so we can do our best to support you.
