The SAFE program is associated with NV Energy and is a "gap-filling" program that is designed to assist people who, through income limitations or other unusual circumstances, find themselves in a situation where they are having difficulty paying their utility bills.

Applicants in Washoe County must first call the phone number to speak with a NV Energy customer services representative, who will prescreen for compliance with SAFE guidelines and make a referral to a local SAFE agent.
