Counseling Corner

Seniors if you plan to take classes this summer you must re-apply to the college. Follow the steps on the "Apply Now" section of the TMCC website. You need to apply for the second summer session so that you will be considered a high school graduate. You will still be able to enroll in first session classes.

Juniors and Sophomores summer registration will begin on April 5th. You may take classes in the summer, but you are responsible for paying the course fees. Registration for fall courses begins on April 21st check your "MYTMCC" account to find out when you can begin checking out of your shopping cart.
