WASHOE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT MANAGEMENT PLAN NOTIFICATION

On October 22, 1986 the President signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response ACT (AHERA) to CFR 763. AHERA requires all school districts throughout the United States, including Washoe County School District, to inspect their schools for asbestos and to develop a management plan which identifies the location of all asbestos in each school.

A requirement of AHERA is that Washoe County School District notifies the public annually that these management plans are available for review in each school's main office.
