Swope Middle School Uniform:

- **SHIRTS:**

- Swope Middle School uniform shirts may be purchased at Kate's Logos @
 - 1221 W. 2nd Street, Reno NV (775)432-1222
- Available for purchase are:
 - Grey and/or Navy polo shirts with the Swope logo
 - Grey and/or Royal Blue Crew neck sweatshirts
 - New Zip Sweatshirt (if available)
- Students may wear long sleeved undershirts of their choice that are solid white, gray, or black with no logos and/or words on them.
- No hoods are to be on clothing worn in the hallways or classrooms.

- **PANTS, SKIRTS, CAPRIS, SHORTS, LEGGINGS:**

- May be purchased at the store of your choice. These are not sold by Kate's Logos.
- Students are to wear solid Khaki, Gray or Black pants, shorts, skirts, capris, or leggings.
- The pants, skirts, capris, shorts, and leggings must be solid with no patterns, designs, large words, or holes.
- Pants, shorts, skirts, capris, and leggings must be worn at the waist.

There are no limitations on accessories or shoes; however, they must comply with the WCSD dress code rules (i.e., no slippers).

The uniform may not be altered in any way. All other WCSD dress code rules will apply.

Outside, students may wear coats and outerwear of their choice to stay warm. When not wearing outerwear, they are to remain in uniform while outside of the school building during school hours (i.e., lunchtime).

If a student is out of dress code/uniform, parents will be requested to bring appropriate uniform clothing for their child.

On free dress days the WCSD dress code rules will be followed.
