Perseverance:

- When you don't understand, ask for help.
 - Please write your questions down and ask when the teacher does quick checks on learning.
 - Your teacher may not see your hand raised immediately so be patient.
- Join the independent learning times with your teacher for extra help.
- No eating during meetings.

Respect

- If you wouldn't say it to someone's face, don't say it online either.
- Be careful with humor and sarcasm.
- Students must use their real names.
- Make sure you know how to raise your "virtual hands" and wait to be recognized when responding to a question or comment.

Integrity

- Don't post or share (even privately) inappropriate material.
- Find an appropriate Distance Learning space in your house.
 - Clear the room of playful pets, or noisy friends and siblings.
 - Sit up straight and tall.
 - Minimize background noise by turning off the TV and radio.
 - Turn off cell phones radios and other devices. (No multitasking during class!)
- Focus on the classroom conversation and activities.
- Do not give out personal information on-line. (Not even Fortnite logins).

Diversity

- Listen and learn to all learning perspectives.
- Talk to the teacher and other virtual school students in a respectful manner, even when disagreeing.

Excellence

- When using the chat feature, if enabled by your teacher, only ask questions and make comments related to the curriculum. **The chat is not a place to have silly conversations with your friends.**
- It's important that virtual school students be prepared before class!
- Take notes on the information presented.
- Do not join sideline chats with classmates when the teacher is speaking.
