

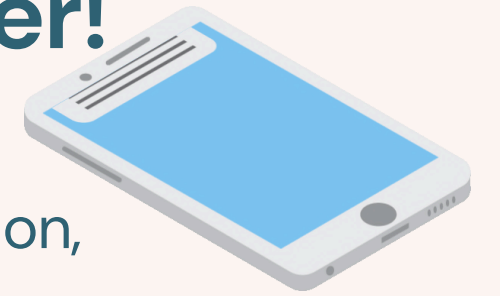
# Congratulations! You've Graduated! Now what???
