The Committee may impose reasonable content-neutral restrictions on public comment such as willfully disruptive comments that are irrelevant, repetitious, slanderous, offensive, inflammatory, irrational, amounting to personal attacks, or interfering with the rights of other speakers. All members of the general public will be expected to wear appropriate face coverings per the Governor's Directives. If members of the public refuse or fail to do so, in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of all members of the general public, staff, and the Committee as well as commiserate with the Governor's Directives, they will be asked to leave the meeting. The Committee will take time to read those comments during the meeting and announce the names of those who provided public comment via email.
