DUE TO EVOLVING CONCERNS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY RESULTING FROM THE COVID-19 EMERGENCY AND PURSUANT TO THE GOVERNOR OF NEVADA'S DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY DIRECTIVE 006 SECTION 1 (EXTENDED BY LATER DIRECTIVES THE MOST RECENT OF WHICH IS DIRECTIVE 041), WHICH SUSPENDS THE REQUIREMENT IN NRS 241.023(1)(B) THAT THERE BE A PHYSICAL LOCATION DESIGNATED FOR MEETINGS OF PUBLIC BODIES WHERE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ARE PERMITTED TO ATTEND AND PARTICIPATE, MEETINGS MAY BE HELD BY TELECONFERENCE ONLY. IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH NEVADA REVISED STATUTES (NRS) CHAPTER 241 (OPEN MEETING LAW) AND ON THE ADVICE OF LEGAL COUNSEL, THE COMMITTEE IS PRECLUDED FROM DELIBERATING AND/OR ACTING ON ITEMS RAISED BY PUBLIC COMMENT WHICH ARE NOT ALREADY ON THE AGENDA.
