





Q18 Are there guidelines in place for tracking revenue from the sale of food and beverages on the school campus during the school day?





Q19 What is the shortest amount of time a student has available to consume breakfast?







Q21 What is the shortest amount of time a student would be provided the opportunity for moderate to vigorous physical activity during the regular school day?





Q22 Does your school allow marketing or advertising of food and beverages on school property (with the exception of nutrition services promotional materials)?













Q27 Are all beverages sold on school campus non-carbonated?








