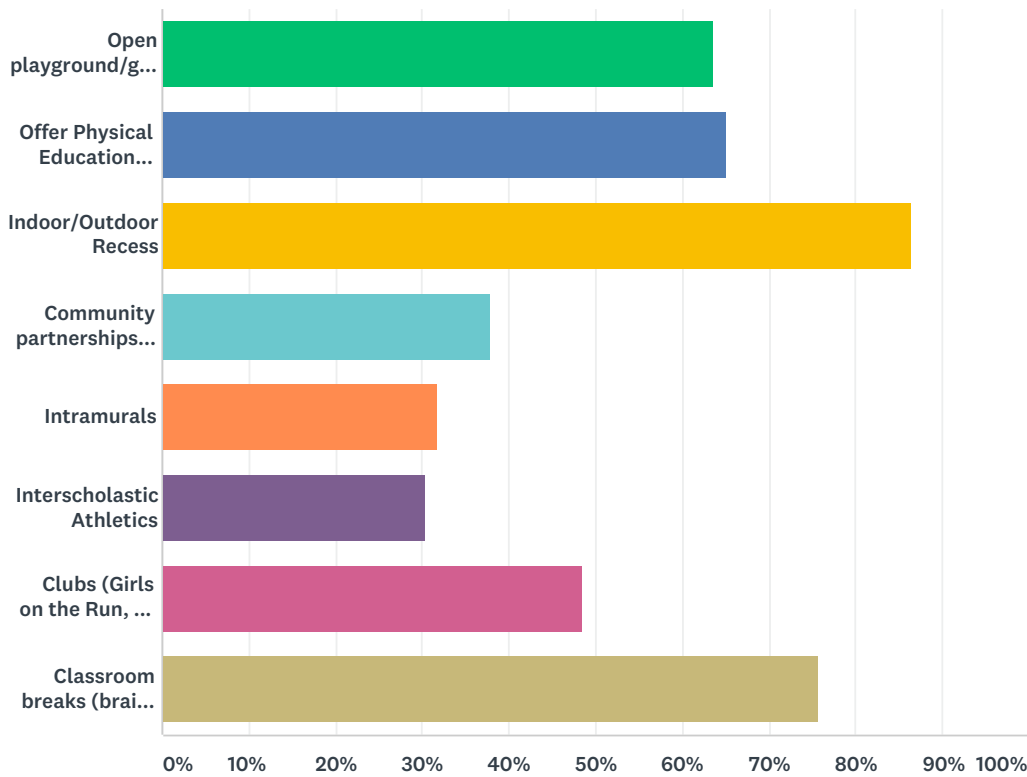

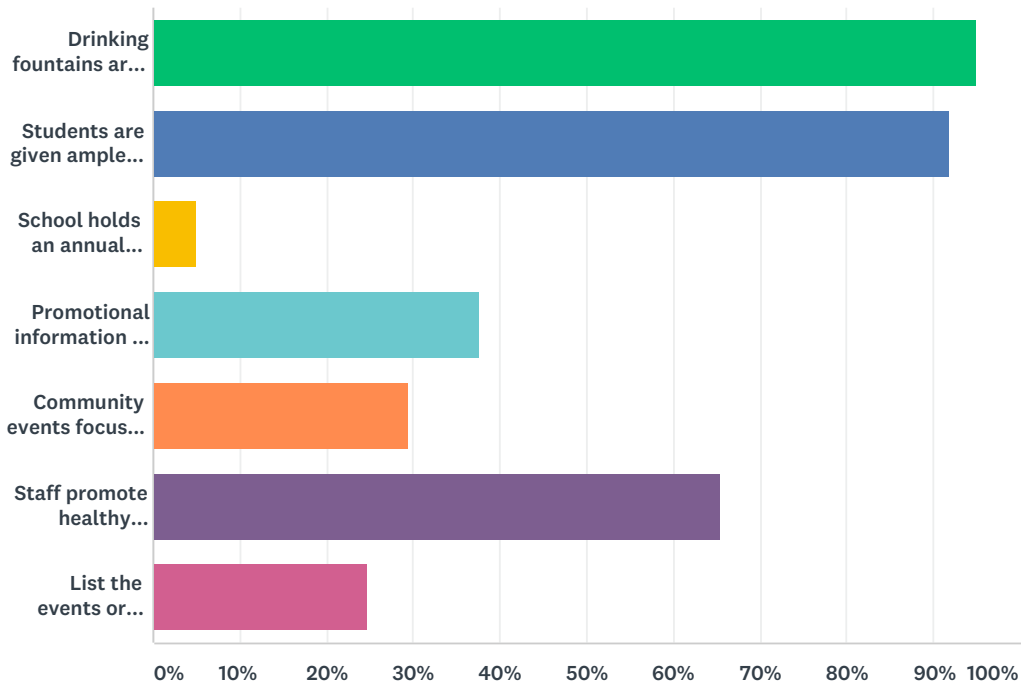

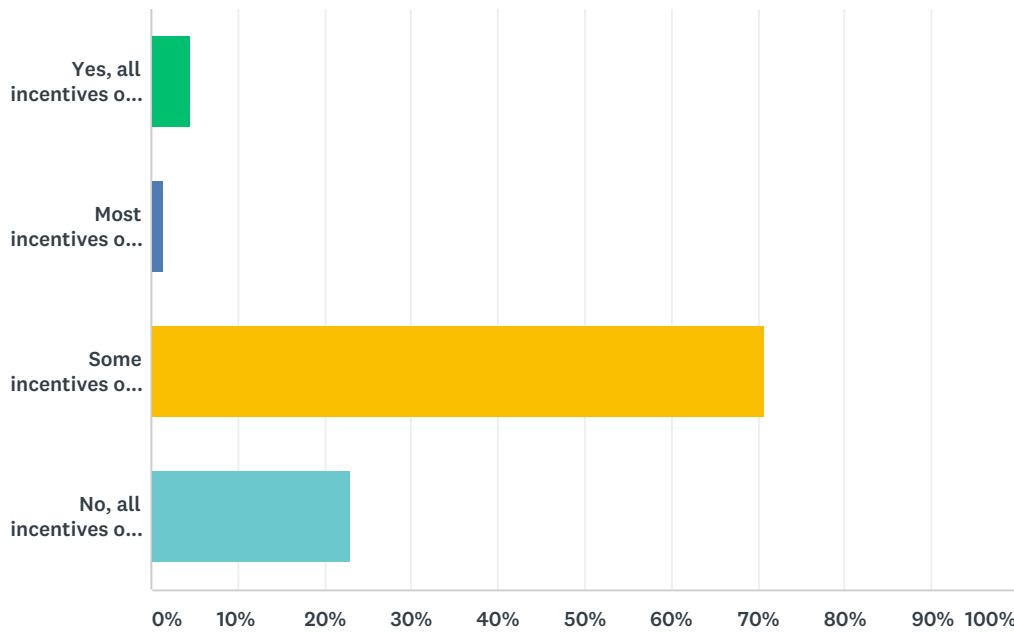

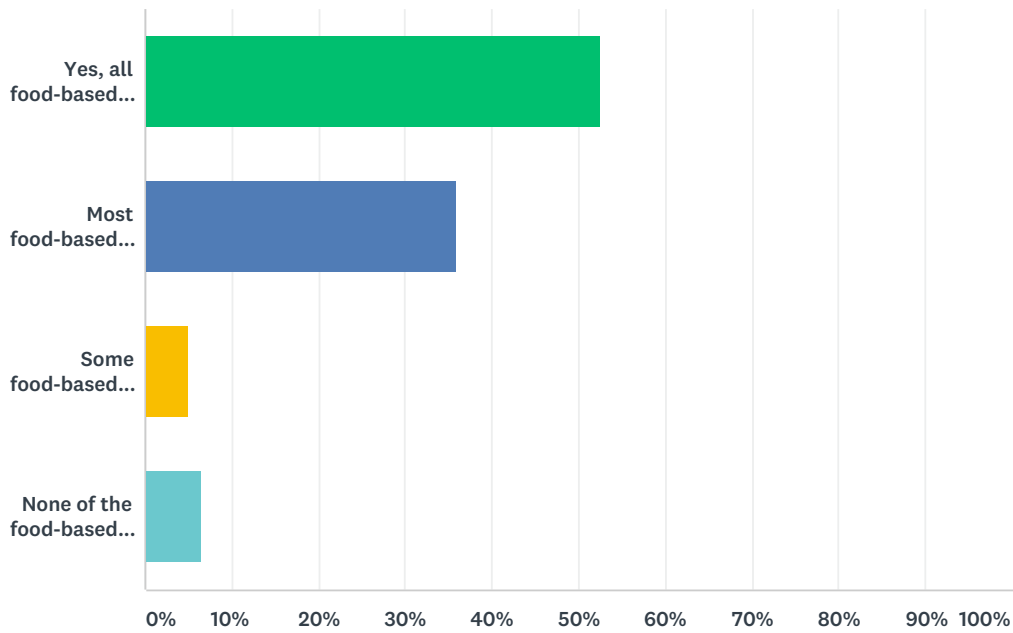

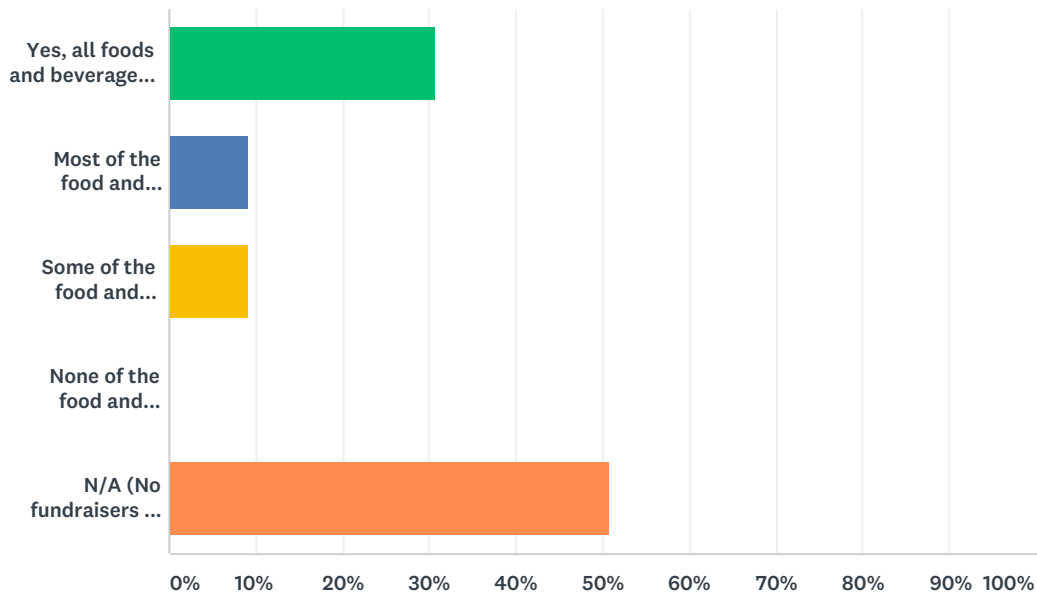

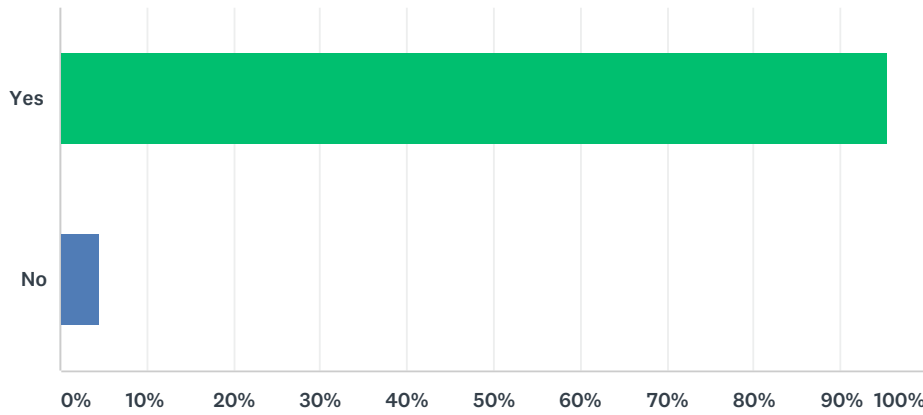

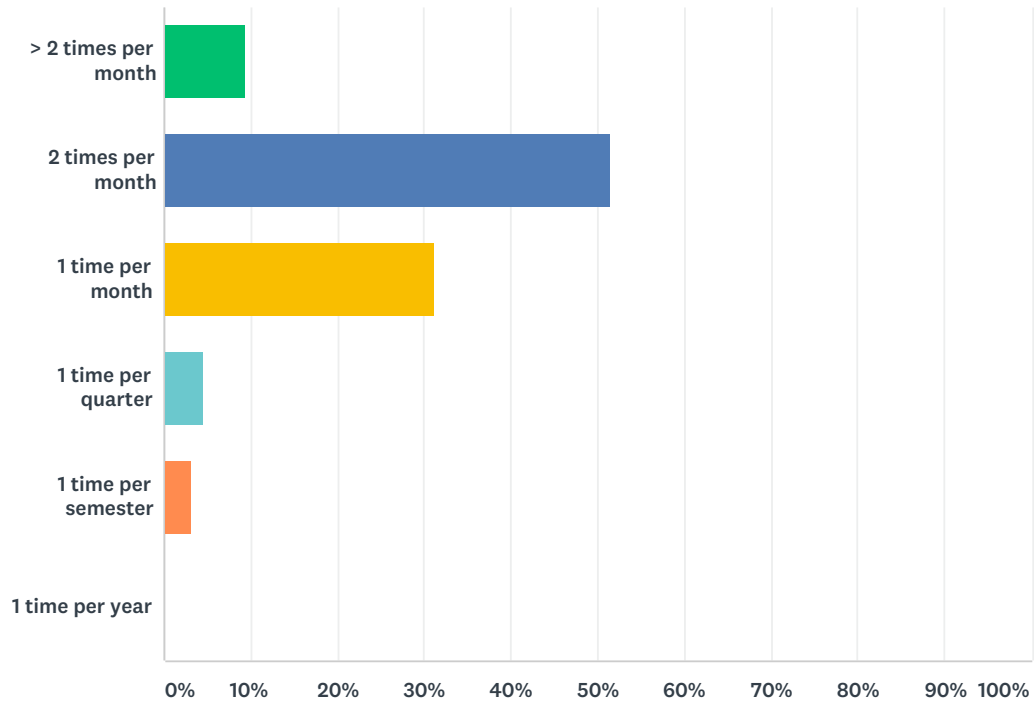

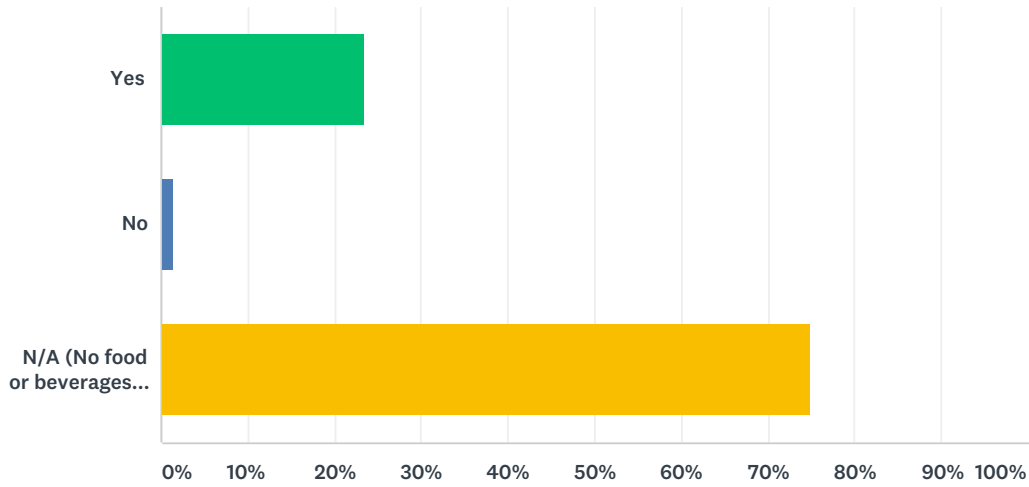

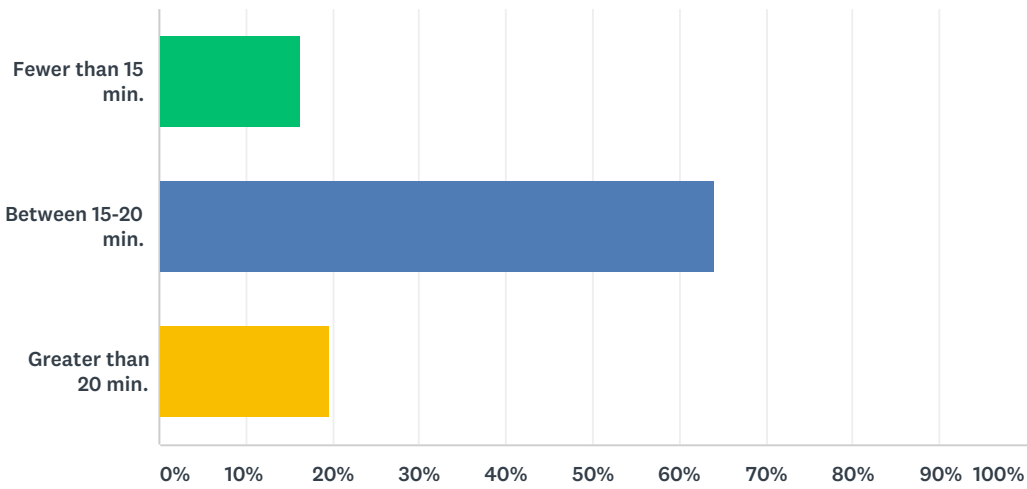

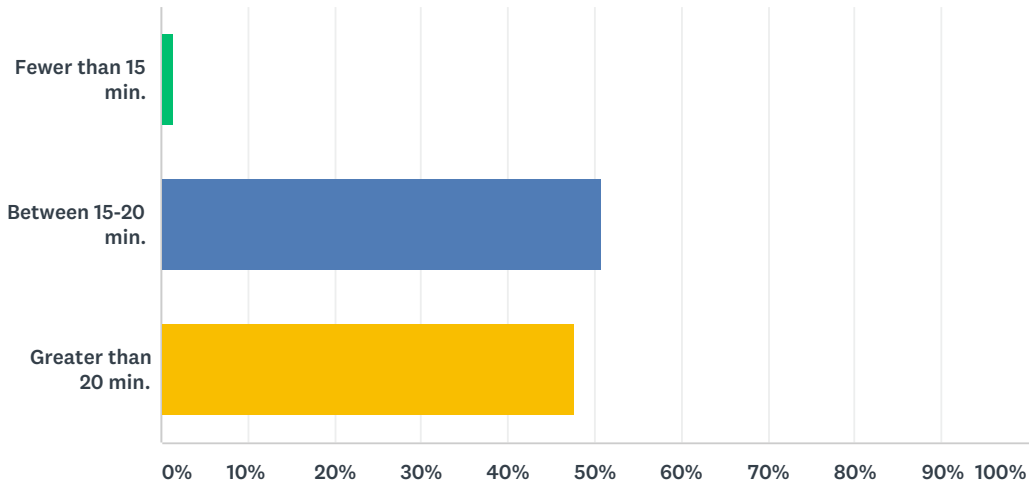

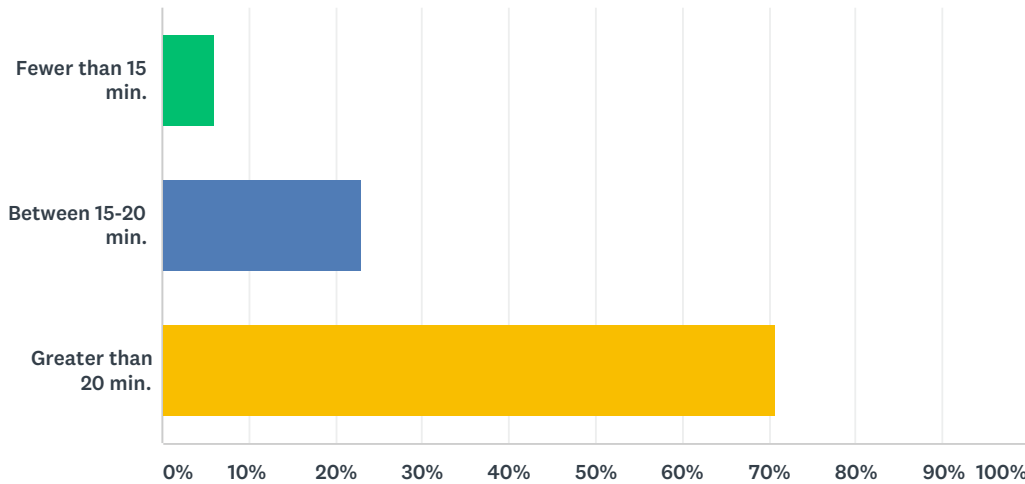

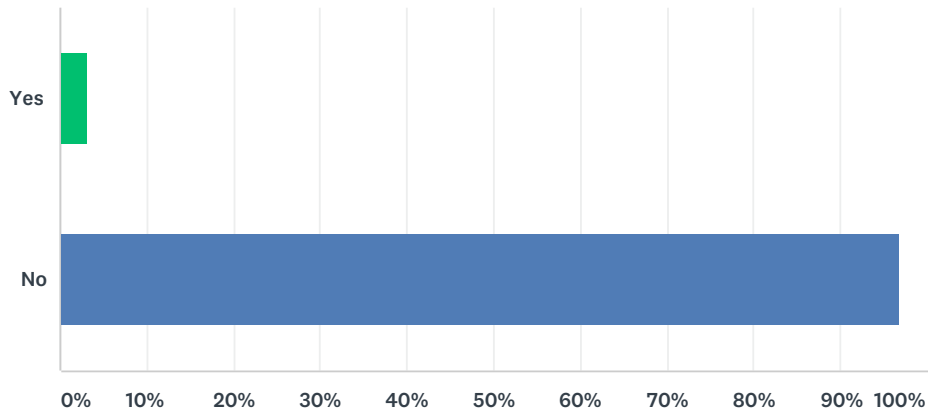

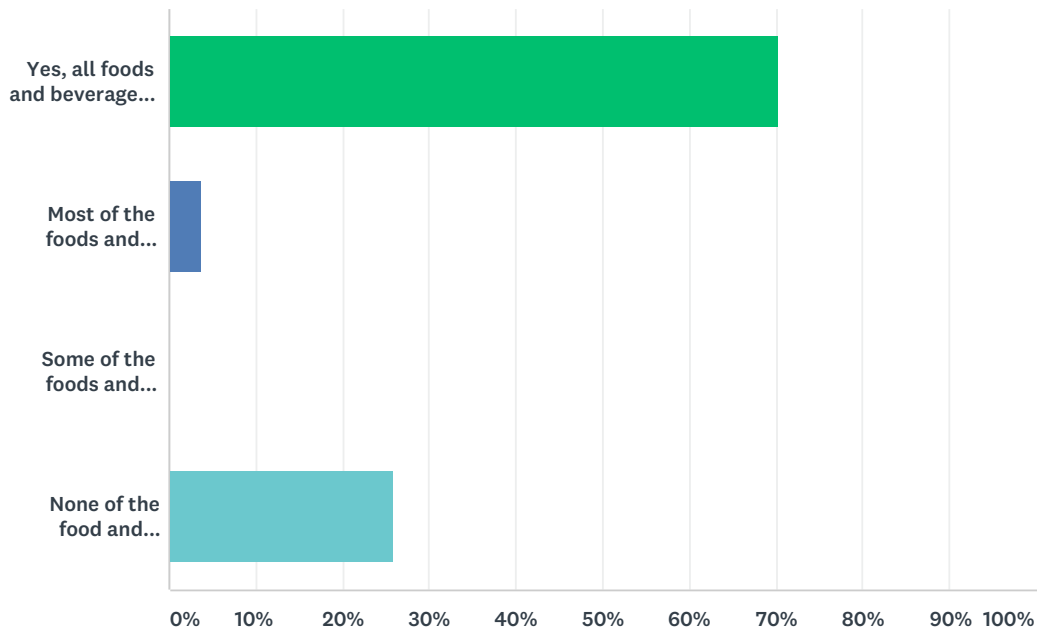

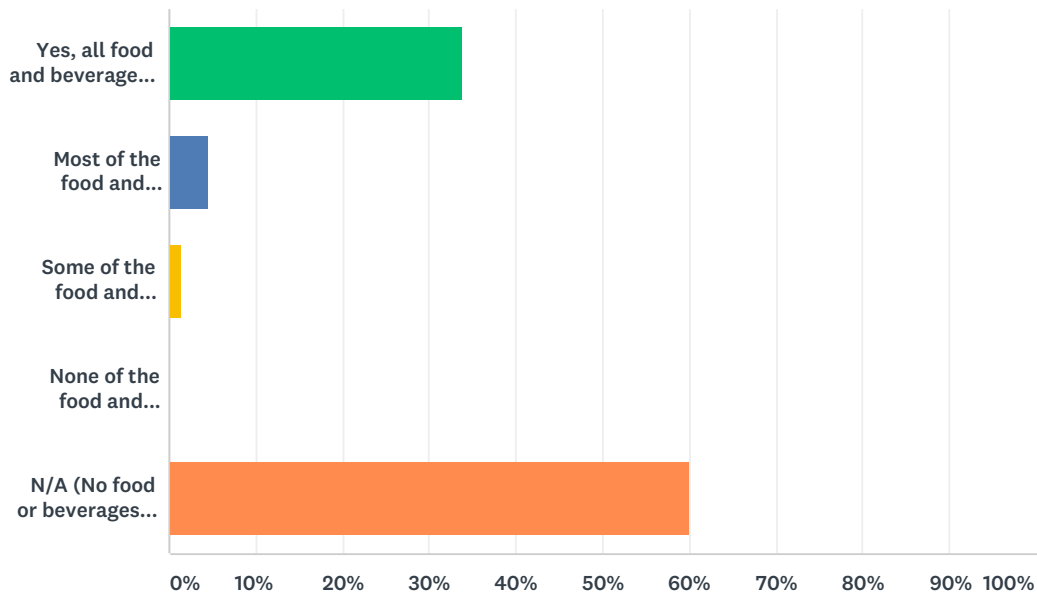

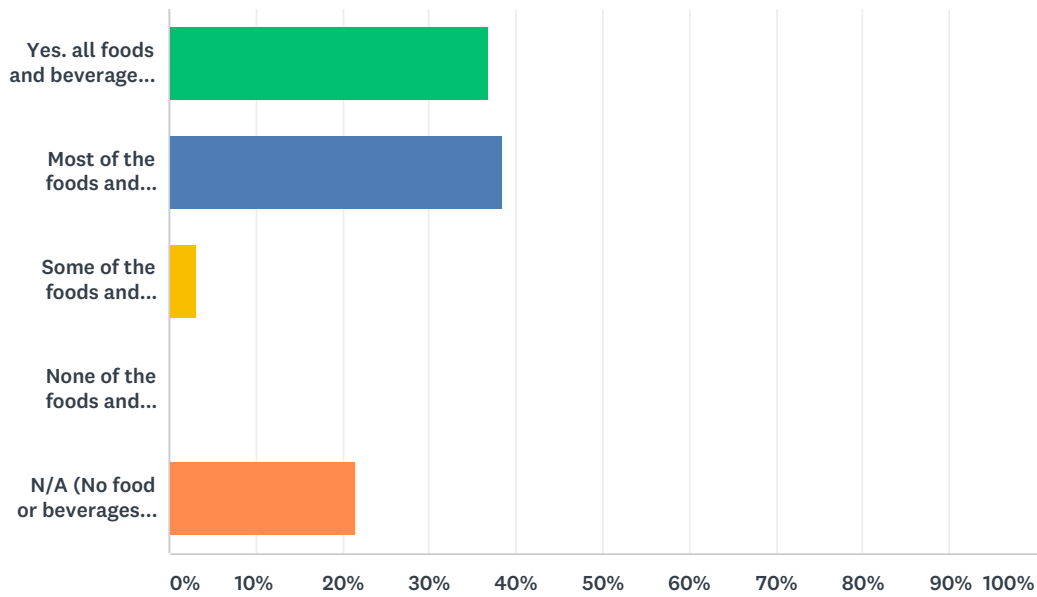

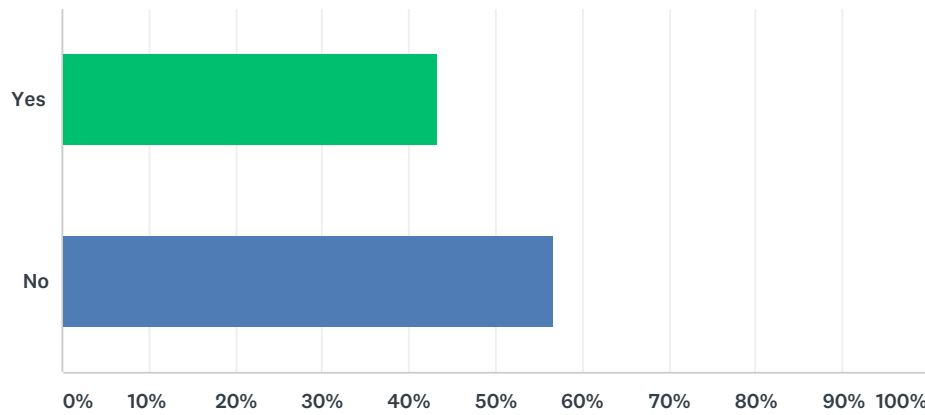

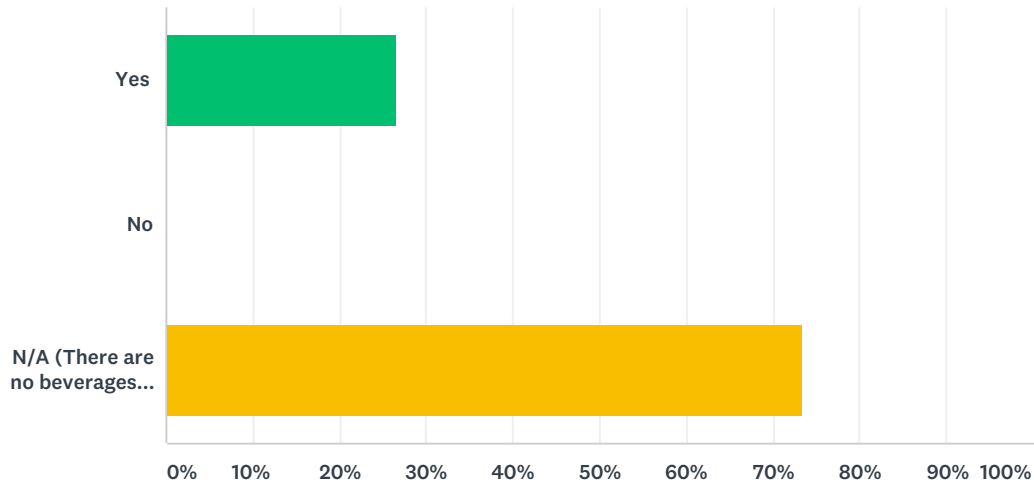

Q27 Are all beverages sold on school campus non-carbonated?

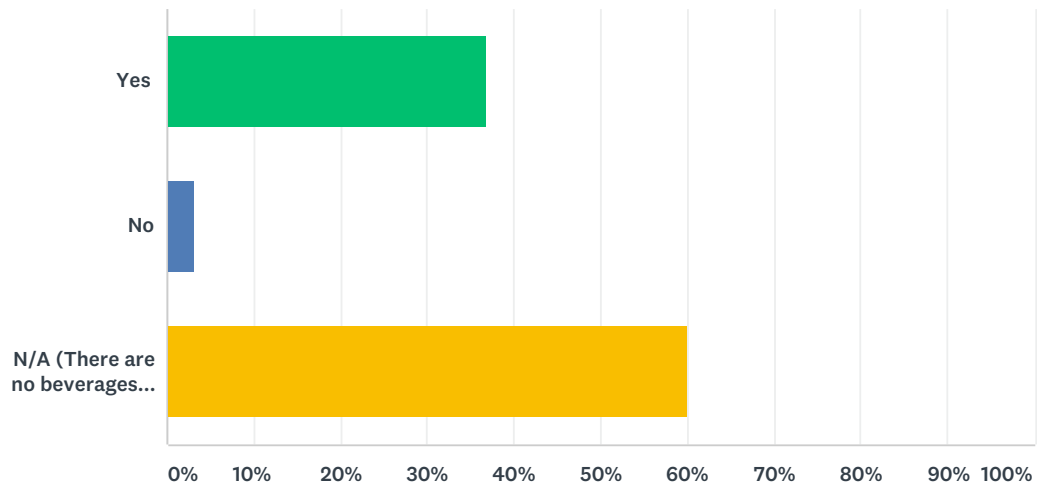

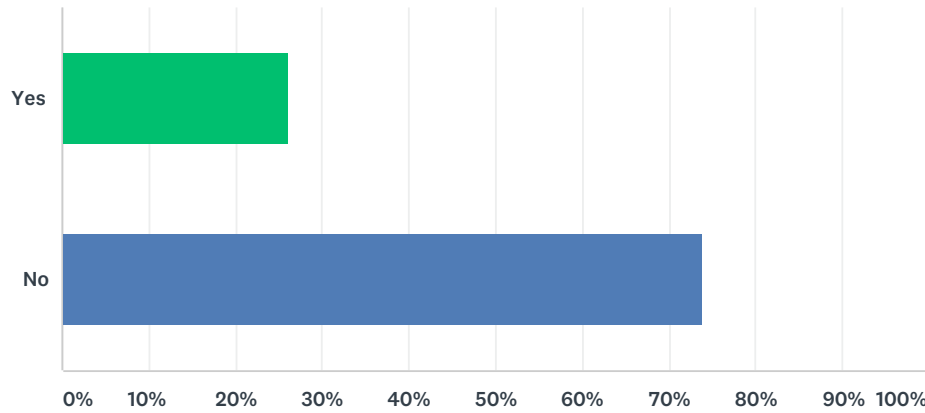

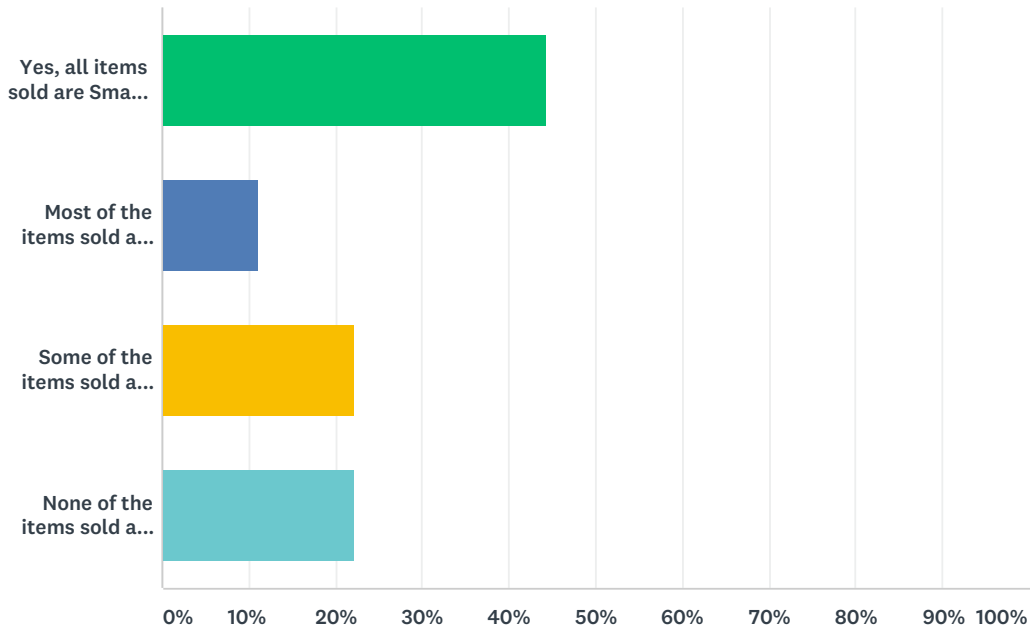

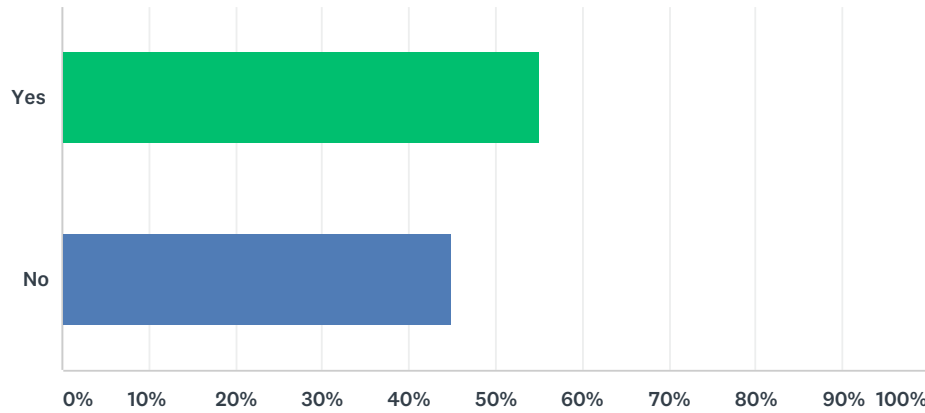
