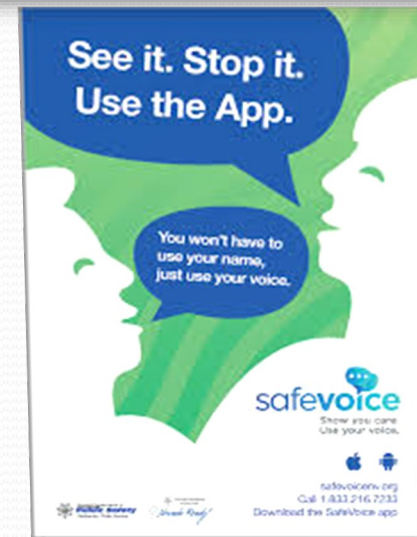

What is SafeVoice?

- A school safety tip line for students, parents, and members of the community 24/7/365
- Available through mobile app, website, or hotline
- Tipster may be **anonymous** or may choose to self-identify
- SafeVoice receives tips concerning the safety of Students and or Schools

SafeVoice Nevada

- SafeVoice provides an anonymous system for students, parents, school personnel, or anyone to submit tips involving students and school safety
- Tips can be submitted via:

When to contact SafeVoice


- Contact SafeVoice when you are reporting:

“about dangerous, violent or unlawful activities, or the threat of such activities, conducted on school property, at an activity sponsored by a public school, on a school bus of a public school or by a pupil enrolled at a public school.”

SafeVoice Tips

- Threat to Staff
- Threat to Student



SafeVoice should **NOT** be used to voice general school complaints, which should be directed to school officials, **or to** prank or harass, which may result in an investigation and consequences.

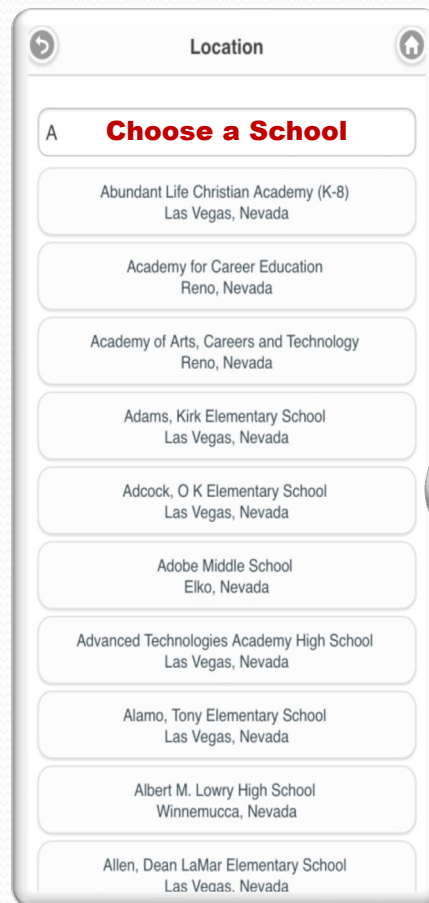

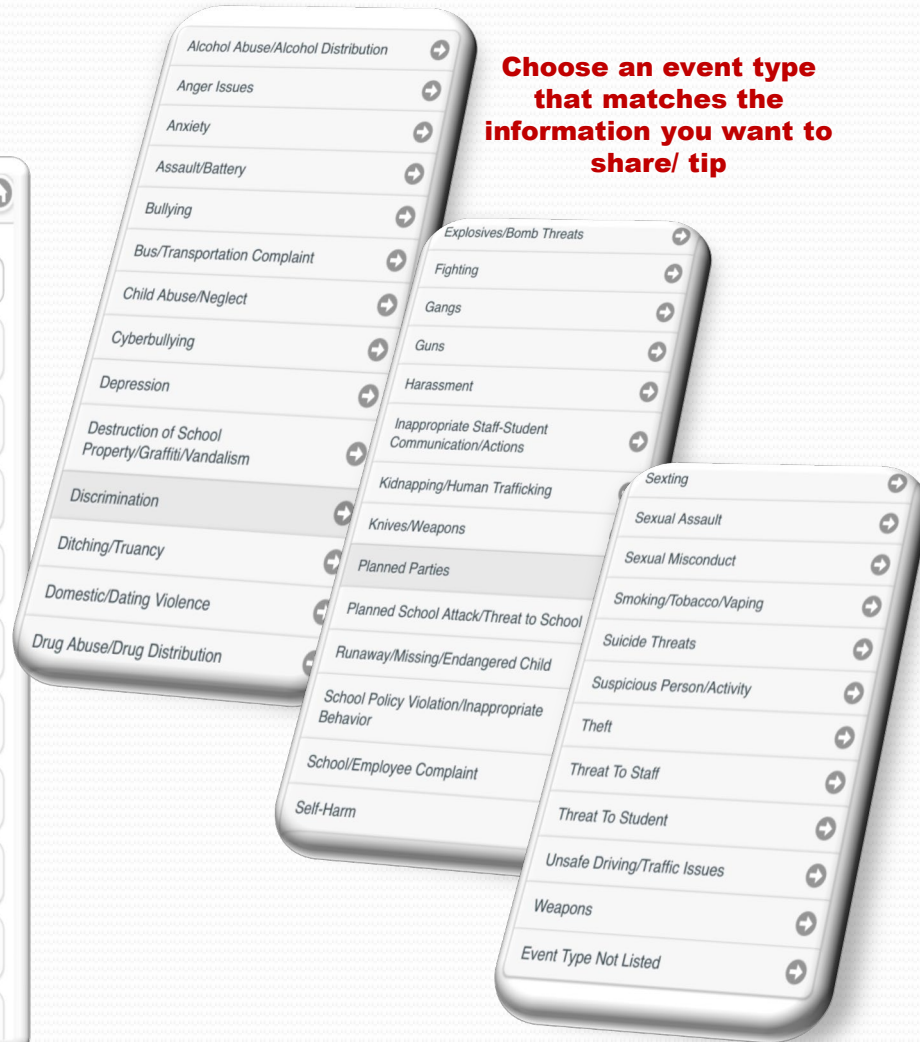

Follow-up

A code will be issued To you When you submit your information. This code can be used To check On the status Of a report Or To answer follow-up questions about the information that you submit. You will also be able To upload additional images Using this code. To follow-up On a report you can log In To our site later Using a code And password that will be assigned To you automatically When you submit this report. Due To the high volume Of information that Is received, the recipient may be unable To reply To every submission.

- ❖ Anyone can make an anonymous tip (*SafeVoice is not to be used as a way to bully, prank or harass others, as there are potential consequences*)
- ❖ A tip can be made by Mobile app, Web, or Phone
- ❖ A tip can be made anytime 24/7/365
- ❖ SafeVoice Communication Specialists are there to communicate with 24/7/365
- ❖ SafeVoice is there to assist with many events types:

Tip events involve activities that cover 3 general areas:

People:

such as—student/individual safety, health, well being

Property:

such as—threats against schools, school events, school property

Policies:

such as--- school policies infractions, discrimination, etc.



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
