Marvin Picollo School is the Washoe County School District's only Regional, Special Education Center specializing in the education of students, ages three (preschool) to twenty-two years old, that have significant physical and intellectual disabilities. Located in South Reno, Picollo School offers students and families an alternative to the traditional mainstream campus setting by providing a wide variety of opportunities that are specially adapted to each student's needs and Individualized Education Program. Through the coordination of a variety of resources not found on the mainstream campus or in the community at large, Picollo School is dedicated to customizing the education programs of students with special needs so that each student served receives a unique, least restrictive and most appropriate educational experience.

What services do we offer students?

- Comprehensive Life Skills Classrooms with a small student to teacher ratio.
