

## Tip #2: Course Map

The course map is the second screen students will see once they click on their course. As a reminder, it shows all activities that are assigned to the student including due dates next to each activity. A nice feature of the course map is that the map will auto load to the next activity in the course (highlighted with a blue square around activity). Remember, they can click on the course report at the top right for a downloadable PDF. Finally, a really nice feature is the salmon colored alert at the top of course map which tells the student about overdue activities and such. They can X out of the alert, but the alert will continue to reappear next time they click inside the course and until they complete the activity stated in the alert.
