We have been approved for an end-of-year concert! Here are the details:

The concert will be held in the gym on **June 2nd at 7 PM**. All attendees, singers and audience alike, must be masked, and stay 3 feet apart from one another (family pods can sit next to each other with a 3' bubble around them). Attendance is capped at 250, and WCSD contact tracing guidelines stipulate that I have an attendance list in the event that someone tests positive in the week following the concert. I was going to have you fill out a form at the bottom, but found out that I could get a QR code to scan, so that's what I have. If you can't scan the code, use the link below. These are the same requirements that sporting events have to follow.


