1. Be in seat when tardy bell rings.

5. **Referral to Administration:** A student will be immediately referred to administration for severe behavior problems or repeated minor offenses.

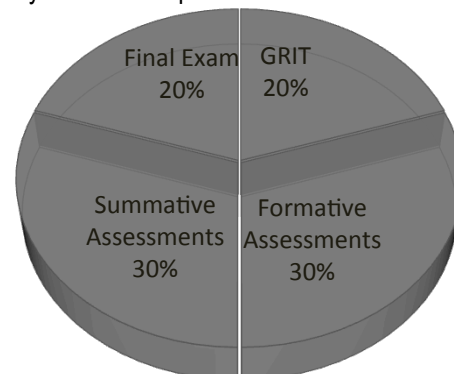
Grades are based on a weighted system according to the categories below. Your final grade will be the grade you earn; they will not be rounded. Your citizenship grade will be your GRIT grade.

→**GRIT:** Are you participating in your learning? This includes classwork, homework, and class participation.

→**Formative Assessments:** Are you understanding what is being taught? Quizzes and lab analysis will help you see where you need to focus your attention.

→**Summative Assessments:** Did you learn the content? This is your unit exams taken at the very end of instruction.

→**Final Exam:** A cumulative exam showing mastery of the concepts covered in the class.



LATE / INCOMPLETE WORK

- Practice/Homework assignments must be 100% complete and turned in on time to be awarded points. When practice work is not turned in on time or is unfinished it will be marked as "incomplete" in the gradebook. If practice work is turned in late it will be marked in the gradebook with a "yes" indicating that the work was later completed.
- Missed tests and quizzes will be marked as missing and scored as a 0% until taken. Tests and quizzes will not be penalized if taken late.

"NO BAGS ABOUT IT"

- Students may NOT have their backpacks at their desk.
- Students are expected to use their lockers OR the designated bin for the duration of class.

ABSENTEE POLICY*** YES, WE DID SOMETHING IMPORTANT WHILE YOU WERE ABSENT.**

- * It is the student's responsibility to check the class task list and file folder to collect any assignments missed. If a student does not find any missing work he or she must check with the teacher.
- * A student has the number of days he/she was absent plus one additional day to collect and submit missed assignments.
- * If a quiz or test was administered on a day a student was absent, the quiz or test should be made up on the first day the student returns.
- * If previously assigned work was due on the day of the absence, the work is due on the first day the student returns.

TEST CORRECTIONS

* For *some* tests and quizzes there will be an opportunity to make corrections AND retake the test.

* Before corrections or a retake can occur the student must complete any missing or incomplete assignments from the unit.

INFINITE CAMPUS

Infinite Campus (<https://campus.washoeschools.net/campus/portal/washoe.jsp>) will be updated regularly. Messages about class progress will be sent home frequently via e-mail through the Infinite Campus Messenger function.

Parents and students are strongly encouraged to check the Infinite Campus Portal on a weekly basis to view the most current grades in all classes.

PLAGIARISM

Plagiarism is taking the ideas and/or writings of another and passing them off as one's own.

In this class, plagiarism includes...

- Turning in another's **work** as one's own
- Copying** work from a friend before class (or while in another class)
- Including a source but failing to **cite** it
- Copying an **author's exact words** and passing them off as one's own

Students caught plagiarizing will be given ZERO for the assignment.

CHEATING

- * The teacher will mark in Infinite Campus that cheating/plagiarizing has occurred.
- * The student will be given a zero for that particular test or assignment.
- * Parent contact will be made if cheating/plagiarizing occurs on major tests, projects, or essays.

CELL PHONES

- Cell phones must be silenced and either put away or placed screen side down on the desk during class.
- At times, the use of phones will be permitted for searching for information, setting reminders, playing review games, using the timer function, etc.
- If cell phones (or any other electronics) are used without permission during class the phone will spend the rest of the period in "phone jail" and can be retrieved at the end of class.
- If a phone makes frequent trips to phone jail it will be confiscated and turned in to the office for a parent to come pick it up.
