Attendance & Tardy Policy

- Attend class each day and do the home learning assignments promptly.
- Be in your assigned seat and ready to start class when the tardy bell rings. Students with excessive tardies will be marked down in their citizenship grade and will receive detentions or other consequences.

Materials required EVERY DAY

- *GoMath* book: Your *GoMath* book **MUST** come to class with you every day! If you lose or destroy your book, you will be required to buy a replacement.
- Binder: Your team binder must have a divider and pockets for your math papers and notes. The
 binder must be organized by date and papers kept the entire year in order to be used for SBAC
 review in May.
- Composition notebook
- Sharpened pencils, colored pencils, and erasers
- You do not need a calculator in class. If you have one you will be able to use it when appropriate.

Phone Use in Class

- Phones need to be in silent mode or off, and placed in pockets or in backpacks during class.
- If a phone goes off in class I will ask for it to be turned off. If it goes off again I take it to the office and the student can get it at the end of the day.
- On days when students take a unit test or final exam, phones will be collected prior to the test.

Late Work

Late homework in an instructional unit is accepted for partial credit until the end of that unit. After a unit is finished, work for that unit will no longer be accepted. Test and quiz corrections will be accepted until the end of each quarter.

o <u>Homework and classwork done in pen will not be accepted.</u> Students will need to redo the assignment and turn it in for partial credit.

Academic Grade

Your academic grade will be determined by the following:

- Homework/Home Learning Day Assignments: Homework will be assigned to support the lessons taught in class. It is due at 2:00 on the Home Learning Day. It is crucial that each student is fully involved with every aspect of the class and Home Learning Day assignments are important for that to happen. Students can expect to have homework assigned after every In-Person Day, including on weekends depending on how the days fall.
- **Quizzes:** Quizzes will generally be given every two-three weeks and may be corrected for additional points.
- Unit Tests: Tests will be given at the end of units. Some unit tests may be retaken or corrected.
- Parents and students will have full access to Infinite Campus to check student grades and progress. Please check IC frequently as it is the best and most current way of keeping track of your student.

Missed Work
