MUSIC CLASSES

INTERMEDIATE & ADVANCED ORCHESTRA

- INTERMEDIATE: Student has successfully completed Beginning Orchestra
- <u>ADVANCED</u>: Student has successfully completed Intermediate Orchestra
- In both classes you will continue to learn the elements of music & improve your technique through required school performances
- INSTRUMENTS: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Brass

INTERMEDIATE & ADVANCED BAND

- <u>INTERMEDIATE</u>: Student has successfully completed Beginning Band
- <u>ADVANCED</u>: Student has successfully completed Intermediate Band
- In both classes you will learn how to read & play more advanced music while having opportunities to perform in concerts
- **INSTRUMENTS**:
- Woodwinds: Flute, Oboe, Basson, Clarinet, Saxophone
- Brass: trumpet, Horn, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba
- Percussion: Drums & mallets

INTERMEDIATE & ADVANCED CHOIR

- INTERMEDIATE: 7th grade or successfully completed Beginning Choir
- ADVANCED: Successfully completed Intermediate Choir and invited to participate in Advanced
- You will deepen your understanding of the elements of music through performance



TECHNOLOGY RELATED COURSES

ADVANCED STEM


LAB FEE: \$20

- Students in 7th or 8th grade can sign up for Advanced STEM whether or not you completed STEM I in 6th grade
- This class is an extension of 6th grade Introduction to STEM. It is a project-based learning experience combining Math, Science, Engineering, and Technology.
- Do you like to work with your hands and be creative with computers? Some of the fun projects will include building cars and animations.

ENGINEERING

LAB FEE: \$25

- You must be a 7th or 8th grader
- It is a project-based learning experience
- This is about learning how to build using engineering standards. Build your own earthquake tower, CO2 car among other projects using various materials.
- Get ready to work your way into a trade school or career as an engineer.



OTHER ELECTIVE CHOICES

SPANISH I & II

- SPANISH I: all 7th graders or any 8th grader who did not take Spanish I in 7th grade
- **this class is NOT recommended for 8th graders. It will be repeated in HS
- SPANISH II: 8th graders who successfully completed Spanish I in 7th grade
- Learn the basic skills to be able to communicate in Spanish.
- Successfully complete Spanish I & II in MS and you can be considered to start with Span III/IV I HS.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Lab Fee: \$10 Uniform Fee

- Any student may repeat PE in 7th and 8th grade
- Students are EXPECTED to dress out and participate DAILY
- PE emphasizes physical fitness and development of basic movement skills through team, individual, and dual sports.
- Learn: rules, sportsmanship, personal responsibility, and leadership.
- Have fun, get strong, and MOVE!


ART II Lab Fee: \$25

- Students in 7th or 8th grade can sign up for Art II whether or not you completed Art I in 6th grade
- You will learn the elements and principles of Art using a variety of mediums, such as: pastels, chalk, watercolor, clay, acrylic paint, graphite pencils, pen/ink over a variety of surfaces.

CULINARY ARTS (AKA FOODS)

LAB FEE: \$40

- Students in 7th and 8th grade can sign up for this class. You can only take the class once and 8th graders have priority, as the class fills up quickly
- You will learn cooking techniques & basic knife skills while preparing everything from entrees to desserts. When completing this class, you will be ready for college, or a trade school, such as Debbi Smith or AACT.

CREATIVE WRITING

- Open to all 7th and 8th graders
