Purpose of Annotation:

To interact with and make visible/deepen your understanding of the text.

6-Annotation Strategies:

- 1. Draw a box around the title and all subtitles.
- 2. Outline and number all the paragraphs.
- 3. Read and underline/highlight vital information or main idea of each paragraph.
- 4. Add in marginalia as you read (write your thoughts, questions, connections in the margins).
- 5. Circle <u>AND</u> define the key words in the article.
- 6. Write a one-sentence summary for each paragraph (if there are 43 paragraphs, then you have 43 one-sentence summaries).

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
