

6 ANNOTATION STRATEGIES

Purpose of Annotation:

To interact with and make visible/deepen your understanding of the text.

6-Annotation Strategies:

1. Draw a box around the title and all subtitles.
2. Outline and number all the paragraphs.
3. Read and underline/highlight vital information or main idea of each paragraph.
4. Add in marginalia as you read (write your thoughts, questions, connections in the margins).
5. Circle AND define the key words in the article.
6. Write a one-sentence summary for each paragraph (if there are 43 paragraphs, then you have 43 one-sentence summaries).

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
