

THE NEVADA BIGHORNS UNLIMITED MIDAS CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

The Mission of Nevada Bighorns Unlimited Midas Chapter is to conserve and improve wildlife resources and habitat in Nevada for every sportsman, hunter, and outdoor enthusiast. We believe with education and participation; our youth will provide a future for Nevada's wildlife and habitat improvement.

This scholarship program was established with the generosity and support of the members of the Nevada Bighorns Unlimited – Midas Chapter. Up to ten \$1000 scholarships may be awarded in May of 2025 for the academic year beginning in the fall of 2025.

The recipients will be selected by a committee of NBU-Midas board members. Members of the committee are looking for scholarship applicants who are well-rounded people, who have demonstrated the ability to work hard, who have a love of Nevada's wildlife and the outdoors, and who have an interest in pursuing a career in conserving, managing, protecting, and studying Nevada's wildlife populations.

These scholarships are available to graduating high school students, first- and second-year college students (entering Freshman or Sophomore year). Scholarships are also available to third- and fourth-year college students (entering Junior or Senior year).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a resident of Nevada and graduate of a Nevada high school.
- Must be a citizen of the United States and be able to provide a valid social security number.
- Major in a study that contributes to our Mission.
- Any change in a major must be made in writing to the NBU-Midas Scholarship Coordinator.
- Maintain 12 hours per semester and a minimum 2.5 GPA per semester and 3.0 cumulative GPA.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Participation in activities, internships, and experience related to hunting, fishing, and wildlife conservation.
- Honors, awards, and leadership skills.
- Answer to essay question.
- Degree plan option and academic achievements.
- Postmarked by March 31st.
